SERIES SNAPSHOT—William Smith and Oglethorpe will square off for the first time on the basketball court today.

LIVIN' LARGE—William Smith earned a berth in the field of 63 by earning one of the 21 at-large bids reserved for Pool C teams (runners-up in automatic qualifying conferences).

HOW WE GOT HERE—The Herons won two games in Bristol Gym to advance to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament. William Smith defeated Colby-Sawyer 76-72 in the first round behind the 27-point effort of **MARISA VESPA**. Two days later, the Herons used a balanced scoring attack that put all five starters in double digits to defeat Brockport 78-73.

TOURNAMENT HISTORY—William Smith sports a 15-10 record, including an 11-0 mark at home, in NCAA Tournament play. The Herons are making their 11th appearance in the Big Dance.

LAST DANCE—The last time William Smith earned a spot in the NCAA Tournament field was 2006. The Herons defeated St. John Fisher in the first round 69-62 before falling to Baldwin-Wallace 71-65 the following day.

LONGEST DANCE—The Herons made their longest foray into the NCAA Tournament in 1997, when William Smith (27-1) reached the quarterfinals before suffering its only loss of the season.

CHALLENGING SLATE—William Smith's 2007-08 schedule featured 11 games against teams that made the 2007 NCAA Tournament. In games against Cortland, George Fox, Hamilton, Ithaca, Keuka, Medaille, Rochester, and St. Lawrence, the Herons posted an 8-3 record.

AGAINST THE FIELD—William Smith's 2007-08 schedule also featured four games against teams that made the 2008 NCAA Tournament. In games against George Fox, Medaille, Rochester, and St. Lawrence, the Herons were 3-3.

POLL POSITION—William Smith entered the postseason at No. 20 in both the USA TODAY/ESPN Coaches poll and the D3hoops.com Top 25. The Herons have been ranked eight consecutive weeks, climbing as high as No. 10 in the coaches poll and No. 13 in the D3hoops.com poll.

NATIONAL NUMBERS—William Smith begins the penultimate weekend of the season ranked among the nation's best in several statistical categories. The Herons are 13th in assist-to-turnover (1.02), 16th in assists (16.8), 16th in winning percentage (.893), 22nd in three-point shooting (.361), 26th in field goal percentage (.437), and 36th in scoring offense (72.1 ppg).

NATIONAL NUMBERS II—Individually, **MARISA VESPA** begins the weekend seventh in the nation in assists, averaging 6.2 per game. She's 17th in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.07) and 29th in steals (3.4).

AT THE HELM—Third-year Head Coach **LINDSAY DRURY** and her assistants, **JULIE HERGENRODER** and **CHARLIE EVANGELISTA**, were voted the 2008 Liberty League Coaching Staff of the Year. It's the second time Drury's staff has been voted tops in the conference, also earning the honor in 2006.

GREAT START—Speaking of Drury, she has a record of 64-20 (.762), earning two NCAA Tournament bids and leading the Herons to the 2007 ECAC Upstate Championship. Her victory total and winning percentage are better than any William Smith boss through three seasons.

EVERYBODY'S ALL-AMERICAN—**MARISA VESPA** is one of 40 nationwide finalists for the 2008 State Farm Coaches All-America Team. Not including Vespa, since 1995, William Smith has had six players earn eight All-American awards, including first-team selections **JENNIFER GOODELL '97** (1996 & '97) and **LIZ BROWN '00** (2000).

PLAYER OF THE YEAR—Watertown, N.Y., native **MARISA VESPA** was voted the 2008 Liberty League Player of the Year. The four-time first team All-Liberty League selection leads the conference in assists (6.21), assist-to-turnover ratio (2.07), and steals (3.36), and ranks second in three-point shooting (.448).

ROOKIE REWARDS—First-year guard **MOLLIE DANAHY** was voted a share of the 2008 Liberty League Rookie of the Year award. The native of Troy, N.Y., is averaging 5.3 ppg and 1.8 spg. A four-time Rookie of the Week honoree, Danahy scored a season-high 18 points at Rensselaer, making 5-of-7 from the floor, including 4-of-5 threes. She is following in the footsteps of **MARISA VESPA** (2005 LL ROTY) and **ERIN CUNNINGHAM** (2007 ROTY).

FAB FIVE—All five William Smith starters earned All-Liberty League honors this season. **MARISA VESPA** collected first team honors for the fourth consecutive year. **PAULA FOOTE**, **STEPHANIE CZAJKOWSKI**, and **ERIN CUNNINGHAM** all received second team honors, while **LATASHA CONEY** received honorable mention.

DEAN OF DISH—**MARISA VESPA** is one of the all-time passing greats in William Smith history. She ranks second in career assists with 576, six behind the career record established by **KIM DENNIN '99**.

EXCLUSIVE CLUB—Speaking of Vespa, she is the only Heron to score 1,000 career points (1,147) and hand out 500 career assists (576).

STOP THIEF—William Smith's premier pilferer is **MARISA VESPA**. She ranks third in career steals with 283, 46 behind No. 2 **JILL KATHMANN '96**.

LUCKY NO. 7—With 12 points against Brockport, **STEPHANIE CZAJKOWSKI** moved into seventh place on the Herons' career scoring list with 1,224 points, 64 behind No. 6 **LAURA HADWIN '03**.

COLLEGE BOARDS—At 6.3 caroms per game, Czajkowski is William Smith leading rebounder and ranks fifth in career rebounds with 738. She is seven boards behind No. 4 **TRENA SUTTON '88**.

EXCLUSIVE CLUB II—Like Vespa, Czajkowski is a member of a very exclusive club. She is one of only five Herons to have scored at least 1,000 career points and grabbed at least 700 career rebounds. **JENNIFER GOODELL '97** (2,042 pts/901 reb), **GWEN SCOTT '82** (1,522/877), **WENDI SCHOFF '98** (1,195/858), and **TRENA SUTTON '88** (1,155/745) are the others.

DAY IN, DAY OUT—A model of consistency and endurance, **STEPHANIE CZAJKOWSKI** has played in every William Smith game over the past four seasons. She has played in a career record 112 contests, starting 103.

HITTIN' THE BOOKS—**STEPHANIE CZAJKOWSKI** was named to the 2008 *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-District Team. It's the second consecutive season she has been so honored. Epitomizing the student-athlete ideal, Czajkowski is equally as impressive in the pursuit of her undergraduate degree as she is in the pursuit of victories. The three-time Liberty League All-Academic honoree is a Dean's List student and a three-time Faculty Scholar. She was inducted into William Smith's Laurel Society—the junior honor society—last year. Czajkowski has also earned the 2006 Award for Achievement in Organic Chemistry and the 2005 CRC First-Year Chemistry Achievement Award.

HITTIN' THE BOOKS II—Four Herons earned a spot on the 2008 Liberty League All-Academic Team. **STEPHANIE CZAJKOWSKI**, **MARISA VESPA**, **PAIGE MYERS**, and **ERIN CUNNINGHAM** have a cumulative grade point average of 3.2 or higher.

ROAD WARRIOR—In 12 games away from Bristol Gym this season, Stephanie Czajkowski is William Smith's leading scorer, producing 12.6 ppg, 6.2 rpg, 1.8 assists, and 1.8 steals. She is also shooting .527 on the road. During the Herons' longest road trip of the season—a five-game swing through the Liberty League—Czajkowski averaged 14.6 ppg and 6.6 rpg, and shot .557 from the floor.

FLYING FOOTE—The first graduate student to compete for William Smith, **PAULA FOOTE** has produced solid numbers this season (9.8 ppg, 3.8 rpg, 2.2 apg), but more importantly to the Herons' success is the example she sets every day with her relentless work ethic. She runs just as hard and fights for rebounds and loose balls everyday in practice as if it were the national championship game. Foote is shooting a career-high .456 from the floor this season, including .402 from behind the arc.

STEPPIN' UP—Junior **LATASHA CONEY** is in the midst of her finest season as a Heron. She has produced career-highs in points (10.5), rebounds (5.2), assists (2.2), and steals (1.8), while shooting a career-best .410 from the floor. Last month, Coney earned a spot on the D3hoops.com National Team of the Week after scoring a career-high in four straight games (culminating with 24 points against Vassar on Feb. 8).

HAPPY DAYS—The 2007 Liberty League Rookie of the Year, **ERIN CUNNINGHAM** is enjoying another fine season for the Herons. She is second on the team in scoring (10.6 ppg) and rebounding (5.7 rpg). Cunningham has scored a season-high 22 points twice, stinging Lycoming on Jan. 12, and St. Lawrence on Feb. 2.

HER HOME GAME—Unlike the rest of her teammates, **ERIN CUNNINGHAM** is playing a home game tonight. The Garden State native lives less than 30 miles from Harwood Arena in Rockaway, N.J. Cunningham averaged 15.6 ppg and was named to the Daily Record's All-Area second team as a senior at Morris Knolls High School.

THE CLASS OF 2008—Over the past four seasons, **STEPHANIE CZAJKOWSKI**, **PAULA FOOTE**, **KRISTEN SUATONI**, and **MARISA VESPA** have led William Smith to an 84-28 (.750) record. They have made three NCAA Tournament appearances and won the 2007 ECAC Upstate Championship. Their current 25-3 record is the program's best record since the 1996-97 squad went 27-1.

RECORD WATCH I—**MARISA VESPA** has 174 assists this season, the second highest total by a Heron. **KIM DENNIN '99** set the bar at 176 in 1996-97. Vespa has produced at least three helpers in every game this season and has at least one assist in 69 consecutive games.

RECORD WATCH II—**MARISA VESPA** has 94 steals this season, fourth on the single

season list, one behind No. 3 **JILL KATHMANN '96** (95 in 1995-96) and seven behind No. 2 **LIZ BROWN '00** (1999-2000). **GAIL EVANS '80** set the Heron benchmark with 109 in 1977-78.

RECORD WATCH III—**MARISA VESPA** has made 94-of-141 free throw attempts this season. She ranks seventh in makes, one behind No. 6 **JENNIFER GOODELL '97** (95 in 1994-95), and ranks sixth in attempts, six behind No. 5 **LAURA HADWIN '03** (147 in 2001-02).

RECORD WATCH IV—**MARISA VESPA** enters tonight's game with the highest single season shooting percentage from behind the three-point arc by a Heron. She has knocked down 39-of-87 attempts for a success rate of .448. The current season standard is .410 (41-of-100) by **LIZ BROWN '00** in 1996-97.

BATTLE OF THE BIRDS—The Herons have gone toe-to-toe with five opponents that have bird mascots this season. Each time William Smith has emerged victorious. The Herons knocked off the Red Hawks of Rensselaer three times, and the Nazareth Golden Flyers, and the Brockport Golden Eagles once. Today's showdown with the Stormy Petrels, a seabird commonly found on the Eastern seaboard, marks the sixth Battle of the Birds.

ON THE RADIO—**WEOS-FM** (89.7/90.3) will broadcast tonight's game. Mike D'Urso will handle the play-by-play duties, while Dan Allen will provide the color commentary. Outside of the listening area, fans can log onto **WEOS** online at www.weos.org.

SCOUTING THE STORMY PETRELS—Oglethorpe brings a 25-5 record into today's contest. Like the Herons, the Stormy Petrels earned an at-large bid into the 63-team field after finishing second in the Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference. Oglethorpe advanced to the Sweet 16 with wins over Piedmont 91-78 and previously unbeaten Thomas More 66-55. The Stormy Petrels are averaging 79.1 points, while limiting the opposition to 66.2. Oglethorpe is also on the plus side in rebounding margin (2.4) and turnover margin (2.9). Junior guard Katie Kulavic leads the team in scoring. The SCAC Player of the Year and three-time first team All-SCAC pick averages 17.2 ppg, 5.1 rpg, 3.2 apg, and 2.0 spg. Kulavic is shooting a team-leading .594 from the floor, .355 from three-point range, and .822 from the line. Second-team All-SCAC guard Anna Findley, also a junior, is contributing 14.9 ppg and leads the team in three-point shooting (73-205, .356), free throw shooting (.885), and steals (3.5). Junior forward Tina Grace is the third Petrel in double digits, scoring 11.5 per night, while collecting 5.6 rebounds. Junior guard Hannah Brooks paces the team's rebounding efforts at 5.7.
