**SERIES SNAPSHOT:** This afternoon's game marks the 76th time the Statesmen and Saints have squared off. Hobart holds a 37-36-2 series lead. The Statesmen won the first meeting in 1901, 10-0, and also boast the longest winning streak in the series, having captured each of the past 11 showdowns. Hobart's 11-game win streak against St. Lawrence is the longest the Statesmen boast against any of their current opponents. The next longest is a seven-game success spree against Alfred.

**PREVIOUS MEETING:** The Saints scored early, but the Statesmen scored often, as Hobart posted a 44-14 victory. St. Lawrence scored the game's first touchdown, but the Statesmen rattled off 37 unanswered points. **CRAIG SWANSON** threw for 296 yards and three touchdowns, completing 21-of-29. Tight end **JEREMY ARCHER** caught just two passes, but both went for touchdowns. Thirty-one different players recorded tackles for Hobart, led by **SKIP GRANTLING** and **DAVID MARSHALL** with six each.

**CONTRASTING STYLES:** Unlike last season's passing blitz against the Saints, the last time Hobart visited Canton, the Statesmen had three different running backs gain over 100 yards on the ground and a fourth back finished with 98 yards. Junior **TY GODINHO** led the way with 150 yards and a touchdown, while classmate **JACK HOLLERAN** was the leading scorer with three TDs and 102 yards. As a team, the Statesmen rushed for 483 yards and seven touchdowns in the 47-0 win.

**STREAK BUSTERS:** Last week's 35-3 win over the Dutchmen spelled the end of a couple of streaks in the Hobart-Union series. The win for the home team marked the first time since 1996 that the host produced a victory. The dominating performance by the Statesmen defense marked the first time in 25 meetings that the Dutchmen did not score a touchdown against Hobart. The last time the Statesmen kept Union out of the end zone was 1975 in a 21-0 win.

**NATIONAL RANKINGS:** The Statesmen are peppered throughout the national statistical rankings compiled by the NCAA. Sophomore defensive back **JAMIE ANDERSON** leads the nation in passes defended (4.0/gm) and is tied for the lead in interceptions (1.5/gm). Junior **DAN SUOZZI** is 24th in receiving yards per game (104.5) and 29th in punt return average (13.0), while senior quarterback **CRAIG SWANSON** is 25th in passing efficiency (150.6). As a team, Hobart is tied for the lead in turnover margin (+3.0/gm), ninth in pass efficiency defense (68.9), and 20th in scoring defense (10.0 ppg).

**MY NAME IS NEO:** Like the main character of *The Matrix*, Hobart's Mr. Anderson certainly saw the game at a different speed last Saturday. **JAMIE ANDERSON** recorded his first three collegiate interceptions and broke up four other passes. The last time a Statesman recorded three picks in one game was Sept. 9, 2000. **TIM BOOTH '03** stepped in front of three Dickinson passes that afternoon, leading Hobart to a 28-13 victory.

**TOP TACKLER:** Opponents would be smart to avoid senior linebacker **DAVID SZENTESY** who has led the Statesmen in tackles in each of the last two seasons. He finished 2002 with 76 tackles, the most by a Statesman since 1997, and a team-best 8.5 tackles for a loss. A 2002 All-UCAA first-team honoree, the native of Lackawanna had a team-high six fumble recoveries and 4.5 sacks. Through two games, Szentesy is again pacing the defense with 16 stops, including two sacks.

**SUPERDAN:** Junior **DAN SUOZZI** is one of the best all-around players in the UCAA. Coming off a season that saw him earn first-team All-UCAA accolades at wide receiver, punter, and return specialist, he leads the league in receiving yards per game and receiving yards per catch. With most of two seasons left to play, Suozzi needs just 737 yards to break 2002 Hobart Hall of Fame Inductee Scott Geise's (Class of '83) career record of 1,889. The special teams standout leads the UCAA in punt return average (13.0 yds/ret) and is sixth in punting average (32.2 yds/p).

**BROKEN RECORD:** Senior quarterback **CRAIG SWANSON** holds 22 school records, including passing yards in a game and a season and passing touchdowns in a game, a season, and a career. The first Statesman to throw for 2,000 yards in a season became just the second Hobart quarterback to reach the 4,000-yard plateau after his 192 yards against Dickinson on Sept. 13. The 2002 Gagliardi Trophy finalist needs just 274 more passing yards and 73 completions to surpass **GREG HELMER '97** (4,501 yds, 392 comp) on both of those career lists.

**HARD TO "TY" UP:** Opposing defenses will have a hard enough time dealing with the Hobart aerial attack, but couple that with the running abilities of junior **TY GODINHO** and they've got double trouble. The UCAA rushing leader in 2002 has increased his yardage each season, racking up a combined 1,802 yards his first two seasons and compiling 11 100-yard rushing games. Last week, he scored three touchdowns on the ground and leads the UCAA in scoring (9.0 ppg).

**HERE'S THE KICKER:** Junior **ERIC AMPUJA** needs just seven more points to tie Shawn Fazio's career record of 102 points by a kicker. Ampuja's 62 extra points already stands as the career mark, while his eight PATs against the University of Rochester in 2002 sits in a tie for the most in a game.

**DOUBLE EDGED SWORD:** If opponents think that shutting down wide receiver **DAN SUOZZI** means putting a stop to the Statesmen's passing game, they better think again. Junior wide receiver **RICK PIÑERO** has the ability to break down defenses as well, averaging over 18 yards per catch last season.

**PRESEASON:** The *Football Gazette* named junior **ALEX BELL** to its preseason All-America team after an impressive sophomore season. The 6-3, 330-pound offensive lineman is an excellent run blocker and possesses the agility to allow the Hobart throwing game to flourish.

**CAPTAINS:** Seniors **CRAIG SWANSON** and **DAVID SZENTESY** and junior **CHRIS PURTELL** will serve as Hobart's team captains during the 2003 season.

**SCOUTING THE SAINTS:** St. Lawrence opened the season with a 15-12 win over Utica, snapping a 22-game losing streak. However, the Saints have lost their last three games, but not by more than 11 points (a 22-11 loss to Union). Junior Brett Hughes leads the ground game, averaging a UCAA best 96.2 yards per game. Junior Jon Blumhagen (140-77-6, 757, 3 TDs) directs the passing game. Defensively, sophomore linebacker Mike Reed leads the team with 39 tackles.

## 2003 GAME SUMMARIES

### Sept. 13, DICKINSON 17, Hobart 16

**CARLISLE, Pa.**—A 31-yard field goal with 14 seconds remaining, sent the Hobart football team to its first season opening defeat since 1999. Dickinson overcame a nine-point fourth quarter deficit with the game's final 10 points.

The Red Devils (2-0) led 7-0 at the end of the first frame. Hobart (0-1) broke through midway through the second quarter on a 26-yard field goal by **ERIC AMPUJA**. Three minutes later, running back **JACK HOLLERAN** ran in from eight yards out to put the Statesmen in front 10-7. Holleran finished with a game-high 116 yards rushing on 20 carries.

Hobart upped its lead to 16-7 when quarterback **CRAIG SWANSON** hit wide receiver **RICK PIÑERO** for a 16-yard strike late in the third quarter. In what proved to be the difference in the game, the point after try was blocked. Swanson completed 16-of-24 for 192 yards and a touchdown, becoming just the second Statesmen to throw for more than 4,000 career yards (4,019).

**DAN SUOZZI** caught a game-high five passes for 102 yards.

Dickinson scored on a 20-yard touchdown run midway through the final stanza, setting up the dramatic last-second kick.

Defensively, **DAVID SZENTESY** led Hobart with 10 tackles, including a sack, while **NOLAN ROBINSON** added nine stops in his Hobart debut.

## Sept. 27, HOBART 35, Union 3

**GENEVA, N.Y.**—A swarming defense led Hobart to a 35-3 victory over Union at Boswell Field. **JAMIE ANDERSON** (pictured right) led the charge with the first three interceptions of his career, racking up 51 return yards in addition to five tackles and four pass breakups. The win evened the Statesmen's record at 1-1, 1-0 in the UCAA, and marked the first time Hobart has beaten the Dutchmen (2-1, 1-1) in Geneva since 1978.

Anderson's first pick, returned 24 yards to the Union one, set up a single yard dive by **TY GODINHO** with 3:21 remaining in the opening frame.

The offense was hitting on all cylinders in the second quarter, scoring 28 unanswered to take a 35-0 lead into the locker room. **DAVID SZENTESY** put Hobart in position for its second score with a 25-yard interception return to the Union 17. Szentesy finished with six tackles, including a sack. Five plays later, Godinho posted his second TD, this time from two yards out with 10:12 remaining in the half. Anderson's second pick also led to a Hobart score, thanks to a 27-yard return to the Union 5. **JACK HOLLERAN** took the first snap in for six.

Hobart's fourth touchdown was a record breaker. Taking over on the Hobart 12-yard line, Swanson heaved a pass down field to **DAN SUOZZI**. Suozzi made the catch near the Hobart 45, juked a defender and out ran another for an 88-yard scoring play. The longest pass play in Hobart history, it eclipsed the 85-yard mark set on a **GREG HELMER '94** to **NATE WAYE '95** pass on Oct. 22, 1994, against Alfred.

Swanson completed 15-of-22 for 209 yards, while Suozzi made four catches for 107 yards. **RICK PIÑERO** led Hobart with a game-high six catches for 38 yards. Godinho, who finished with 63 yards rushing, closed out the first half scoring with his third TD of the game, an 11-yard scamper with 1:17 remaining.

The Dutchmen offense meanwhile, managed no yards of offense in the first 15 minutes, and just 76 in the first half. Union particularly struggled with third down conversions, finding success on just three of 17 opportunities for the game.
