**SERIES SNAPSHOT:** The Statesmen and the Mariners will square off for the seventh time this afternoon. Merchant Marine won the first meeting 7-0 back in 1962. In fact, the Mariners won the first four showdowns. Hobart has won the previous two meetings, including last season's 27-9 triumph in Geneva.

WHEN LAST WE MET: On Oct. 15, 2005, 14th-ranked Hobart limited Merchant Marine to minus-10 yards rushing en route to a 27-9 victory on Boswell Field. **DOUG BLAKOWSKI** rushed for 149 yards and three touchdowns, including a season-long 80-yard score. **SHAWN MIZRO** threw for 202 yards and a touchdown, connecting with **JAMES WRIGHT** five times for a game-high 107 yards. **JIMMY GRADIS '06** led the Statesmen with 10 tackles, while **JEFF SANDERS** contributed nine stops. **ANDY PURDIE** accounted for two of Hobart's six sacks.

**WELL RESTED:** Hobart enters this afternoon's Liberty League showdown 14 days removed from its last game. The Statesmen have fared well following an off week, posting a 5-2 record since the start of the 1999 season.

**AWARDS A-PLENTY:** In Hobart's 19-14 win over WPI on Sept. 30, **DOUG BLAKOWSKI** rushed for 119 yards and all three of the Statesmen's touchdowns. He also caught two passes for 49 yards. His efforts earned him the Liberty League Offensive Performer of the Week, the RACA Male Athlete of the Week, and the ECAC Northwest Offensive Player of the Week awards.

**MAKINGA STAND:** Defensive tackle **RYAN ARUCK** was named to the D3football.com Team of the Week following his performance against WPI on Sept. 30. He recorded a team-high nine tackles (four solo) as the Hobart defense stopped two WPI trips inside the red zone. On those scoreless trips in the red zone, Aruck had solo tackles on both fourth down plays.

**IN THE ZONE:** Hobart is one of only two football team in New York to score on every single one of its trips inside the red zone. The Statesmen are 13 for 13 this season, scoring seven rushing touchdowns, three passing TDs, and booting three field goals. Columia is the other (six for six in four games).

**RED MEANS STOP:** Conversely, the Statesmen lead the Liberty League in red zone defense. Hobart has stopped the opposition four times in the red zone, blocking a field goal, intercepting a pass, and holding on downs twice.

**DEJA VU ALL OVER AGAIN:** The Statesmen improved to 4-0 for the third time under Head Coach **MIKE CRAGG**, but neither of the previous 4-0 starts have left so little margin for error. Hobart's four wins have come by three, four, seven, and five points.

**FUMBLEROOSKI:** What a difference a week makes. In Week 2, Hobart lost four fumbles and need a fourth quarter comeback to beat William Paterson. In Week 3, the Statesmen forced four fumbles and held off a fourth quarter comeback try by Rensselaer.

**IRRESISTIBLE FORCE:** Speaking of fumbles, linebacker **EVAN HOFFMAN** is making

the most of his senior season. The native of Fairfield, Conn., leads the nation in forced fumbles (1.0/g) and is second on the team in tackles with 31. After recording nine stops, two forced fumbles, and recovering a fumble at RPI, he was named the ECAC and Liberty League Co-Defensive Player of the Week.

**SLICIN' AND DYSON:** Senior wide receiver **NICK DYSON** led Hobart with three receptions for 26 yards against WPI. For the season, he's caught six passes for 65 yards after catching just one pass in his first three seasons.

**TIME ON OUR SIDE:** The Statesmen lead the Liberty League in time of possession. Hobart is averaging 32:22 per game. The Statesmen held on to the ball a season-high 33:37 in their win over WPI.

**SCORING MACHINE:** Running back **DOUG BLAKOWSKI** has accounted for eight of Hobart's 14 touchdowns this season. The second-year starter leads the team, ranks second in the Liberty League, and is fifth in the nation in points per game (12.0).

**LONG RANGE PROJECTIONS:** Speaking of **DOUG BLAKOWSKI**, the senior is averaging two rushing touchdowns per game, putting him on pace to eclipse his total of 17 in 2005. The Hobart record for rushing touchdowns in a season is 19, set by **DON ALEKSIEWICZ '73** during the 1971 season.

**BICENTENNIAL MAN:** Senior linebacker **NOLAN ROBINSON** recorded his 200th career tackle against Rensselaer. He made a team-high 11 stops against the Engineers and bosts 207 for his career. Robinson is second in the Liberty League in tackles, averaging 9.0 per game.

**BIG BOOMER:** Junior punter **DOMINICK ANCONA** shared the Liberty League Special Teams Performer of the Week award after launching two 52-yard punts against William Paterson. He averaged a single game record 47.2 yards per punt and also recovered a pair of Pioneer fumbles on kickoff returns. Ancona leads the Liberty League and ranks 10th in the nation in punting average at 40.7 yards/p.

**RECOVERY TIME:** Punter **DOMINICK ANCONA** and defensive end **JIM DRURY** share the Liberty League lead in fumbles recovered. Ancona, who also handles kickoffs, recovered a pair of loose balls against William Paterson, while Drury pounced on two fumbles by Rensselaer.

**SOMETHINGS GOTTA GIVE:** One of the most intriguing match ups in today's game is Hobart punter **DOMINICK ANCONA** vs. Merchant Marine punt returner Jake Miller. While Ancona leads the Liberty League and ranks 10th in the nation in punting (40.7 yds/p), Miller leads the Liberty League and ranks 10th in the nation in punt return average (17.1 yds/pr).

**MANY HAPPY RETURNS:** Junior wide receiver/kick returner **STEVE SORHAINDO** and sophomore wide receiver/kick returner **RYAN LiDRAZZAH** are among the national leaders in kick returns this season. Sorhaindo is 18th with a 28.2-yard per return average, while LiDrazzah is 22nd at 27.6 yards per return. Sorhaindo was named the Co-Special Teams Performer of the Week after averaging 31.0 yards per return and catching three pass for 40 yards against RPI.

**LATE GAME HEROICS:** Quarterback **SHAWN MIZRO**, a two-time All-Liberty League pick, has led Hobart on game-winning drives in the fourth quarter or overtime seven times in his career, including three of this season's four games.

**DRAMATIC COMEBACK I:** Hobart trailed Dickinson 28-24 with less than two minutes remaining on Sept. 9. The Statesmen put the game in the capable hands of **SHAWN MIZRO**. The senior led Hobart on a nine-play, 80-yard drive for the game-winning score. He completed six of nine passes, including the game-winning 12-yard toss into the corner of the end zone to **RYAN Lidrazzah**.

**DRAMATIC COMEBACK II:** Hobart trailed at William Paterson 21-16 with less than two minutes remaining on Sept. 16. The Statesmen scored twice in a span of just 60 seconds to take a 31-21 lead. The first touchdown came on a 3-yard pass from **SHAWN MIZRO** to **KYLE MARTIN**, capping a 10-play, 72-yard drive. A minute later, **DOUG BLAKOWSKI** ran in from 2 yards out. The one-play scoring drive was set up by **COREY CAGE'S** second interception of the season.

**DRAMATIC COMEBACK III:** Hobart trailed WPI 14-13 with less than six minutes remaining on Sept. 30. **SHAWN MIZRO** engineered a seven-play, 67-yard touchdown drive that ended with a 1-yard scoring plunge by **DOUG BLAKOWSKI**. While his overall performance was not overly impressive (24-12-3, 138 yds, 0 TDs), Mizro was at his best when it mattered most, completing four of five passes for 65 yards on the game-winning drive.

**ROOKIE REWARDS:** First-year kicker **DENIS AVDIC** is second on the team in scoring this season with 19 points. He's converted 10 of 12 PATs and all three of his field goal attempts from 20, 23, and 39 yards out. Avdic (pronounced av-ditch) was name the Liberty League Co-Rookie of the Week after the Dickinson game.

**CAGEY VETERAN:** Junior cornerback **COREY CAGE** has made a smooth adjustment from the offensive side of the ball to defense. In four starts at his new position, the former running back has 16 tackles, five pass break ups, and two interceptions. Cage leads the team in passes defended and interceptions.

**BALANCE IS THE KEY:** Hobart's offense is so tough to stop because there are so many options. Statesmen quarterbacks have completed passes to six wide receivers, four running backs, two tight ends, and a linebacker, while eight different players have carried the ball.

**14 AND COUNTING:** Against WPI, Hobart won its record 14th consecutive home game. The Statesmen have not lost on Boswell Field since Nov. 8, 2003.

**HE'S THE BOSS:** Now in his 12th season, Head Coach **MIKE CRAGG** boasts a career record of 77-37. He is Hobart's all-time leader in wins and is second in winning percentage (.675) and games coached (114).

**SCOUTING THE MARINERS:** Merchant Marine enters today's game with a 3-3 record, including a 1-2 mark in the Liberty League. The Mariners have lost three of their last four outings, including last weekend's 28-24 defeat at Rochester. The offense is averaging 303.5 yards per game (102.2 rushing, 209.7 passing). Defensively, Merchant Marine is allowing 311.8 yards per game (135.0, 168.5). Quarterback Chuck Kleinschnitz has thrown for 1,258 yards and six touchdowns, but has been intercepted five times. Jon Spiropoulos (19 rec, 203 yds, TD) and Preston Morgan (18, 298, 2) are his top targets. On the ground, John Watson has a team-high 298 yards and two touchdowns. On the other side of the ball, Garron Edgington leads the team with 53 tackles, while Art Dahlin boasts a Liberty League leading eight sacks.

**PASS HAPPY, LEAVE SAD:** A key stat in relation to the outcome of today's game will be the balance between the run and the pass by the Mariners. In Merchant Marine's three wins, the offense has run the ball more often than it has thrown it. In the Mariners' three defeats, the team has passed nearly twice as often as it has run.

**GOING TO EXTREMES:** Mariners fans have seen a lot of sacks this season. Merchant Marine leads the Liberty League in sacks by (16, 2.7/g) and sacks allowed (30, 5.0/g).

**ON THE AIR:** Every Hobart football game will be carried live by WEOS-FM (89.7/90.3 in Geneva, 88.1 in Ithaca). Veteran play-by-play man **TED BAKER** and color commentator **GREG TULL** will describe the action.

**UP NEXT:** Hobart travels to St. Lawrence University to take on the Saints on Oct. 21. Kickoff for the Liberty League contest is scheduled for 1 p.m.
