SERIES SNAPSHOT: The Statesmen and the Saints will square off for the 79th time this afternoon. Hobart won the inaugural meeting 10-0 in 1901. The Statesmen are currently riding a 14-game winning streak over their northern neighbors, the longest winning streak in the history of the series. St. Lawrence last topped Hobart in 1991, shutting out the Statesmen 41-0 in Canton.

INSIDE THE SERIES: St. Lawrence has outscored Hobart 1,355-1,279 in the 78-game history of this rivalry. The Statesmen boast the two most lopsided wins in the series, defeating the Saints 57-0 in 1997 and 54-0 in 1956. SLU's biggest win was a 51-0 shutout in 1931. Twenty-three meetings have been decided (if at all) by seven points or less. Hobart holds a 13-8-2 lead in those contests. During the Statesmen's current 14-game winning streak, Hobart has outscored St. Lawrence 438-145 (+20.9/g). The Saints' longest win streak in the series is five games between 1987 and 1991.

WHEN LAST WE MET: On Oct. 22, 2005, 11th-ranked Hobart overcame a constant rain that turned Boswell Field into a quagmire and a determined St. Lawrence squad to improve to 7-0 with a 13-9 Liberty League victory. Running back **DOUG BLAKOWSKI** rushed for 116 yards on 24 carries. The Saints got their lone touchdown on a fake field goal, but missed the extra point. The Statesmen answered when **SHAWN MIZRO** hit **RYAN LIDRAZZAH** on a 9-yard touchdown pass. The extra point gave Hobart the lead. A 32-yard field gave SLU the lead heading into halftime, but Mizro's 31-yard TD pass to **COLBY FEANE '06** in the fourth quarter proved to be the game-winner and the only points of the second half. Linebacker **JEFF SANDERS** ended the Saints' final drive with his first interception of the season. He led the Statesmen with eight tackles (5 solo).

WELL RESTED: Hobart improved to 6-2 in games following a week off since the start of the 1999 season with a 30-19 win at Merchant Marine last Saturday. The Statesmen jumped out to a 20-0 lead and boasted a 30-7 advantage with five minutes remaining in the Liberty League contest. The Hobart offense produced a season-high 450 yards, including 326 on the ground. **DOUG BLAKOWSKI** was a workhorse, producing a career-high 214 yards rushing and a touchdown. **SHAWN MIZRO** was an efficient 11 of 19 for 124 yards and two touchdowns without an interception. He also ran for a touchdown.

PERFECT 10: The Hobart defense was also exceptional at Merchant Marine. The Statesmen limited the Mariners to just 48 yards rushing, including minus 12 in the third quarter, while sacking the Academy's quarterback 10 times. It's the most sacks in a game for Hobart since the Statesmen dropped Bridgewater State 10 times on Nov. 18, 2000, in the first round of the NCAA playoffs.

TEAM OF THE WEEK: Defensive end **ANDY PURDIE** led the pass rush against the Mariners with a career-high 3.5 sacks, while linebacker **EVAN HOFFMAN** added three sacks. Both players earned a spot on the D3football.com Team of the Week. Purdie's 3.5 sacks are the most by a Statesman since **ROB GOULD '01** recorded 3.5 sacks at Franklin & Marshall on Oct. 17, 1998.

IN A RUSH: Running back **DOUG BLAKOWSKI** was named the Liberty League Co-Offensive Performer of the Week and the ECAC Northwest Offensive Player of the Week

after rushing for a career-high 214 yards and a touchdown against Merchant Marine. His 214 yards are the most by a Statesman since **KEITH BRANDON '01** ran for 215 yards against Alfred on Oct. 24, 1998.

SPECIAL AWARD: Kicker **DENIS AVDIC** was named the Liberty League Special Teams Performer of the Week following Hobart's win at Merchant Marine. The Statesmen's No. 2 scorer booted a 27-yard field goal and added three more points on PATs. For the season, Avdic is 4-for-4 on field goals and 13-of-16 on extra points.

RAISING THE BAR: The Statesmen have increased their rushing total each week this season. Hobart will have a tough time continuing that trend though, after rushing for 326 yards at Merchant Marine. While running back **DOUG BLAKOWSKI** has reaped the rewards (5 weekly awards so far), the offensive line has toiled in relative anonymity. Starters T **MIKE DePERSIS**, G **NINO GIAMBRONE**, TE **KYLE MARTIN**, G **BRIAN OHMAN**, T **PHILL PERKINS**, and C **MIKE CONDON**, as well as several key reserves, have improved dramatically since Week 1, when the Statesmen managed just 64 yards rushing.

IN THE ZONE: Hobart is the most effective team in New York State in the red zone this season. The Statesmen have scored 13 touchdowns (9r/4p) and kicked four field goals in 18 trips inside the opponent's 20-yard line. Hobart's 94.4 percent success rate is more than 10 percent better than the No. 2 school in the state, Ithaca (84.0%, 21-25).

RED MEANS STOP: Conversely, the Statesmen lead the Liberty League in red zone defense. Hobart has stopped the opposition five times inside the Statesmen 20, blocking a field goal, intercepting a pass, and holding on downs three times.

DEJA VU ALL OVER AGAIN: The Statesmen improved to 5-0 for the third time under Head Coach **MIKE CRAGG**. The two previous Hobart squads to reach 5-0 (2002, 2005) both won games No. 6 and No. 7 before suffering their first defeats in Week 8.

TOPS IN THE NATION: Linebacker **EVAN HOFFMAN** is making the most of his senior season. The native of Fairfield, Conn., leads the nation in forced fumbles (0.8/g) and is second on the team in tackles (38) and sacks (4.0). In addition to his D3football.com Team of the Week honors this past week (see note on p. 1), he was named the ECAC and Liberty League Co-Defensive Player of the Week after recording nine tackles, two forced fumbles, and a fumble recovered at RPI.

SLICIN' AND DYSON: Senior wide receiver **NICK DYSON** has tied for the team lead in receptions in each of the past two games. Against WPI, he recorded three receptions for 26 yards, while notching three catches for 18 yards at Merchant Marine. For the season, he's caught nine passes for 83 yards after catching just one pass in his first three seasons.

TIME ON OUR SIDE: The Statesmen lead the Liberty League in time of possession. Hobart is averaging 33:12 per game. The Statesmen held on to the ball a season-high 36:31 in their win over the Mariners.

BIG BOOMER: Junior punter **DOMINICK ANCONA** leads the Liberty League and ranks 15th in the nation in punting average (39.3 yds/p). He shared the Liberty League Special Teams Performer of the Week award after launching two 52-yard punts against William Paterson.

CAGEY VETERAN: Junior cornerback **COREY CAGE** has made a smooth adjustment from the offensive side of the ball to defense. In five starts at his new position, the former running back has 19 tackles, five pass break ups, and two interceptions. Cage leads the Liberty League in passes defended.

RECOVERY TIME: Punter **DOMINICK ANCONA** and defensive end **JIM DRURY** share the Liberty League lead for the most fumbles recovered. Ancona, who also handles kickoffs, recovered a pair of loose balls against William Paterson, while Drury pounced on

MANY HAPPY RETURNS: Junior wide receiver/kick returner **STEVE SORHAINDO** and sophomore wide receiver/kick returner **RYAN LiDRAZZAH** are among the national leaders in kick returns this season. Sorhaindo is 16th with a 28.2-yard per return average, while LiDrazzah is 17th at 28.0 yards per return.

LATE GAME HEROICS: Quarterback **SHAWN MIZRO**, a two-time All-Liberty League pick, has led Hobart on game-winning drives in the fourth quarter or overtime seven times in his career, including three times already this season.

DRAMATIC COMEBACK I: Hobart trailed Dickinson 28-24 with less than two minutes remaining on Sept. 9. The Statesmen put the game in the capable hands of **SHAWN MIZRO**. The senior led Hobart on a nine-play, 80-yard drive for the game-winning score. On that drive, he completed six of nine passes, including the game-winning 12-yard toss into the corner of the end zone to **RYAN LiDRAZZAH**.

DRAMATIC COMEBACK II: Hobart trailed at William Paterson 21-16 with less than two minutes remaining on Sept. 16. The Statesmen scored twice in a span of just 60 seconds to take a 31-21 lead. The first touchdown came on a 3-yard pass from **SHAWN MIZRO** to **KYLE MARTIN**, capping a 10-play, 72-yard drive. A minute later, **DOUG BLAKOWSKI** ran in from 2 yards out. The one-play scoring drive was set up by **COREY CAGE'S** second interception of the season.

DRAMATIC COMEBACK III: Hobart trailed WPI 14-13 with less than six minutes remaining on Sept. 30. **SHAWN MIZRO** engineered a seven-play, 67-yard touchdown drive that ended with a 1-yard scoring plunge by **DOUG BLAKOWSKI**. While his overall performance was not overly impressive (24-12-3, 138 yds, 0 TDs), Mizro was at his best when it mattered most, completing four of five passes for 65 yards on the game-winning drive.

ON THE HORIZON: Quarterback **SHAWN MIZRO** has thrown for 5,229 yards in his career, 449 yards shy of the Hobart record set by **CRAIG SWANSON '04** (5,678).

BALANCE IS THE KEY: Hobart's offense is so tough to stop because there are so many options. Statesmen quarterbacks have completed passes to six wide receivers, four running backs, two tight ends, and a linebacker, while eight different players have carried the ball.

14 AND COUNTING: Against WPI, Hobart won its record 14th consecutive home game. The Statesmen have not lost on Boswell Field since Nov. 8, 2003.

SCOUTING THE SAINTS: St. Lawrence carries a 3-2 record into this afternoon's game, sporting wins over Norwich, Johns Hopkins, and Rensselaer. The Saints have alternated wins and losses this season, defeating the Red Hawks in their most recent game, 42-38. SLU is averaging 334.6 yards of offense per game (109.8 rush/224.8 pass), while allowing 320.6 yards per game (149.2/171.4). Quarterback Matt Bezio has thrown for 1,067 yards, completing 79 of 148 passes. He's thrown 10 touchdowns and has been intercepted seven times. Brett Young and Mike O'Donnell are Bezio's top targets, accounting for a combined total of 46 receptions for 736 yards and eight touchdowns. On the ground, Connor Hackett leads St. Lawrence with 235 yards and three touchdowns. Defensively, linebacker Hank Anderson leads the team with 43 tackles, while linebacker Judin Pierre-Louis and linebacker Ryan McConville are tied for second with 35 each. Linebacker Jerred Jones has a Liberty League best three interceptions.

ON THE AIR: Every Hobart football game will be carried live by WEOS-FM (89.7/90.3 in Geneva, 88.1 in Ithaca). Veteran play-by-play man **TED BAKER** and color commentator **GREG TULL** will describe the action.

UP NEXT: Hobart travels to Alfred to take on the Saxons on Oct. 28. Kickoff for the non-conference contest is scheduled for 1 p.m.
