SERIES SNAPSHOT—This afternoon's meeting between the Statesmen and Engineers marks the 51st meeting between the two conference rivals. Rensselaer leads the overall series 25-24-1, but Hobart has won each of the past five showdowns.

GET COMFORTABLE, THIS COULD TAKE A WHILE—The last time these two teams met in Geneva, Sept. 24, 2005, Hobart needed three overtimes to prevail 56-48 over Rensselaer. It's the longest overtime game in Hobart's history. Home field has been an advantage for the Statesmen in the series as they are 12-9-1 against the Engineers on Boswell Field.

A HOUSE DIVIDED—Forgive **MIKE** and **DONNETTE RAYHILL** if they don't know which team to cheer for at Boswell Field on Saturday. Their son Tom is a senior linebacker and team captain for Rensselaer, while their son **JAMES** is a first-year defensive end for Hobart.

ONE YEAR AGO—On Sept. 23, 2006, No. 19 Hobart outlasted No. 24 Rensselaer 24-17 in Troy, N.Y. The Statesmen built a 24-3 lead through the first 50 minutes of the contest and weathered a pair of late scores by the Engineers to open Liberty League play. RPI out-gained Hobart 326-262, but fell victim to four lost fumbles.

WINNING WAYS—Since the start of the 2000 season, Hobart is one of the most successful football teams in the nation. The Statesmen are 19th overall in winning percentage during that time span, amassing a 55-17 record (.764). That's the highest winning percentage of any Division III football program in New York State. Ithaca is next in 22nd place (.756).

WELCOME HOME—Hobart's first game on Boswell Field this season was an exciting 27-26 upset of then 22nd-ranked Carnegie Mellon. **ANDREW STROM** threw for 247 yards and three touchdowns, while **JAMES WRIGHT** hauled in eight of those throws for 99 yards. **DOMINICK ANCONA** was 3-for-3 on point after tries and booted field goals of 40 and 29 yards. **JUSTIN HAGER** led the Statesmen defense with 19 tackles.

TERRIBLE TWOS—The Statesmen fell behind the Tartans 13-0, but grabbed their first lead, 27-20, with 4:47 remaining in the fourth quarter. Unfazed, Carnegie Mellon marched 63 yards in 11 plays, capped by a 1-yard Travis Sivek touchdown run, to make it 27-26. The Tartans went for two and the lead. After running 60 rushing plays and just seven pass plays, CMU naturally tried to throw for the points. The pass was bobbled as the intended receiver fell out of bounds preserving the one-point lead.

REPEAT WINNER—For the second straight week, **ANDREW STROM** was named the Liberty League Co-Offensive Performer of the Week. Through Hobart's first two games, he has completed 66.7 percent of his passes (44-66) for 439 yards and four touchdowns. Strom is third in the conference in passing yards per game (219.5) and passing efficiency (142.5).

EXTRA SPECIAL—Like Strom, **DOMINICK ANCONA** was named the Liberty League Special Teams Performer of the Week for the second consecutive week. He has scored nine points in each of the first two games, a total that is fifth on Hobart's single game list for kickers. The Ancona family is doubly proud this week, as Dominick's younger brother Blaise, a first-year punter at Union, was named the League's Co-Rookie of the Week.

BUSY AFTERNOON—Junior inside linebacker **JUSTIN HAGER** was all over the field against Carnegie Mellon. He finished the game with 19 tackles, the most stops by a Hobart player in more than a decade. The last time a Statesman recorded that many tackles was Sept. 9, 1995, when **JESSE TRULEY '96** logged 19 during a 31-14 loss at Dickinson. Hager's performance was rewarded with the Liberty League Defensive Performer of the Week and the ECAC Northwest Defensive Player of the Week awards.

PASS FAIL—The Hobart defense limited Dickinson to just 49 passing yards (6-16-0) and Carnegie Mellon to just 21 (2-9-1), marking the first time since 2002 that the Statesmen have held two opponents in the same season under 100-yards passing.

CONSECUTIVELY?—Since you ask, the last time the Hobart pass defense held back-to-back opponents under 100 yards through the air was 2001. St. Lawrence threw for just 54 and the following week, Rochester managed only 87.

WHAT'S THE GOLD STANDARD?—In the Mike Cragg era, the 2000 Statesmen are considered the gold standard when it comes to pass defense. Hobart's first gridiron squad to qualify for the NCAA Playoffs set a Division III record for lowest completion percentage (31.3%, min. 250 att). In seven of Hobart's 11 games that year, the opposition failed to record at least 100 yards passing, including each of the first four games.

RIGHT ON TARGET—Making his first start for Hobart, **ANDREW STROM** completed 22 of 26 passes for 192 yards and a touchdown at Dickinson. His 84.6 completion percentage is a record for a Statesman in his first start and the second highest mark all-time. **SHAWN MIZRO '07** set the standard by completing 17 of 19 at Coast Guard in 2005. In addition to showcasing his accuracy, Strom also showed off his mobility by rushing for 34 yards and a touchdown.

SOMETHING'S GOTTA GIVE—Hobart enters Week 3 atop the Liberty League in third down conversion, gaining the first down marker 52.6 percent of the time (20-38), while Rensselaer holds the League lead for opponent's third down conversion, allowing the opposition to move the chains just 17.9 percent of the time (5-28).

TIME IS ON OUR SIDE—The Statesmen lead the Liberty League in time of possession, holding on to the football for an average of 33 minutes, 33 seconds. The Engineers are sixth in the League, averaging 29:07.

DEFENSE! DEFENSE! DEFENSE!—Today's match up features two of the best defenses in the Liberty League. Hobart is first in passing defense (35.0 yds/g), pass efficiency defense (47.5), and opponent fourth down conversion (25.0%, 1-4), and second in total defense (303.5 yds/g) and opponent first downs (32). Rensselaer leads the League in scoring defense (5.0 ppg), rushing defense (33.0 yds/g), total defense (149.5), opponent first downs (21), and opponent third down conversion (17.9%), and is second in pass efficiency defense (89.0).

INSIDE THE NUMBERS—While Hobart outperformed Dickinson in nearly every category on the box score—outgaining its host 444-278, recording 26 first downs to 13, and controlling the clock 37:57-22:03—the Statesmen lost one crucial category, turnovers. The Statesmen fumbled twice, setting up a pair of Red Devil scores. The second miscue and 86-yard return for a touchdown gave Dickinson an improbable 27-24 lead with 47 seconds left in regulation.

SECONDARY SUCCESS—Hobart's pass defense was credited with six pass break ups at Dickinson. The Statesmen also had six break ups at Rowan in last year's NCAA Playoffs. Hobart hasn't recorded more than six in a game since Oct. 31, 1998, when the Statesmen broke up 13 passes against Ithaca.

SHARING THE WEALTH—At Dickinson, Hobart's quarterbacks (in addition to Strom, **RICH DOYLE** completed 5 of 9 for 63 yards) connected with nine different receivers. Junior wideout **RYAN LIDRAZZAH** caught a game-high six passes (for 44 yds), while senior **JAMES WRIGHT** and junior **ZACH SCHULZ** caught four passes each and shared game-high honors with 49 yards.

TOUGH ROW TO HOE—The Statesmen will play a 10-game schedule this season for the first time since 1997. Both the non-conference and Liberty League slates will be challenging waters to navigate. Hobart opens the season with three straight games against 2006 postseason participants. Dickinson (Sept. 8) and Carnegie Mellon (Sept. 15) both earned NCAA bids, while Rensselaer (Sept. 22) won the ECAC Northeast Bowl. The schedule concludes with another tough trio. Alfred (Oct. 27) beat Rochester (Nov. 10) in overtime in the ECAC Northwest Bowl and Union (Nov. 3) earned an NCAA bid.

STATESMEN SUSTAIN SUCCESS—Including last year's 8-2 mark, the Hobart football team has posted 10 consecutive winning seasons, a program record. Prior to the current streak of sustained success, the benchmark for winning campaigns was eight, established by the Hobart teams of 1921 through 1928.

CONFERENCE CROWNS—Hobart earned a share of the 2006 Liberty League championship thanks to the Statesmen's 31-21 win over Rochester, coupled with Rensselaer's 24-19 win over Union. Both teams finished with a 5-1 conference record. It's the sixth time since 1998 that Hobart has captured at least a share of the league title.

SECOND CENTURY—Now preparing for their 114th varsity season, the Statesmen have made six postseason appearances over the past seven seasons (6 NCAA bids, 1 ECAC Bowl). That's an impressive turnaround after earning just a single postseason invitation—an ECAC bowl bid that was turned down—in the program's first 100 seasons.

HE'S THE BOSS—Now in his 13th season, Head Coach **MIKE CRAGG** boasts a career record of 82-40. He has been named the Liberty League Coach of the Year four times and was the AFCA Regional Coach of the Year in 2002. Cragg is Hobart's all-time leader in wins and is second in winning percentage (.672) and games coached (122). On Oct. 6 at Susquehanna, he will become the Statesmen's all-time leader in games coached, surpassing the 124 of the legendary **J. EDWARD TRYON**.

LENDING A HAND—Head Coach **MIKE CRAGG** is assisted by Offensive Coordinator **KEVIN DeWALL '00**, Defensive Coordinator **SCOTT YODER '01**, linebackers coach **AARON BACKHAUS '00**, receivers coach **MATT CUTAIA (UConn '05)**, quarterbacks coach **JON DRACH (Western Michigan '04)**, running backs coach **JOHN MANLEY (Brockport '72)**, and **TERRY MUFFLEY (East Stroudsburg '74)**.

2007 CAPTAINS—Hobart seniors **ANDREW STROM** and **JEFF SANDERS** and junior **RYAN ARUCK** were voted by their peers to serve as team captains this season.

SCOUTING THE ENGINEERS—Rensselaer brings a 2-0 record to Boswell Field following a 34-10 win over Endicott and a 24-0 shutout of Utica. The Engineers feature a balanced attack that averages 144.5 yards on the ground and 288.0 through the air. Junior QB Jimmy Robertson is expected to start under center. He has thrown for 576 yards and six touchdowns this season. Senior WR Brendan McGowan is his top target with 14 receptions for 243 yards and two touchdowns. Junior RB Issac Williams is RPI's top ball carrier with 116 yards rushing and a TD to date. Defensively, the Engineers are allowing just 149.5 yards per game (33.0 run, 116.5 pass). Senior LB Anthony Casale leads four players with double digits in tackles with 19.

ON THE AIR—Every Hobart football game will be carried live by WEOS-FM (89.7/90.3 in Geneva, 88.1 in Ithaca). Veteran play-by-play man **TED BAKER** will describe all of the action.

Game 1 • Dickinson 30, Hobart 27 (OT)

Sept. 8, 2007

CARLISLE, Pa.—Hobart lost its season opener in heartbreaking fashion, falling to Dickinson 30-27 in overtime. The Statesmen were 4-0 in overtime entering the game.

The Statesmen grabbed the early lead when QB **ANDREW STROM** drove his team down the field on the opening drive. Hobart covered 74 yards in 10 plays, capped by a 10-yard scoring run by Strom.

Making his first start for the Statesmen, Strom completed 22 of 26 passes for 192 yards and a touchdown, while rushing for 34 yards and a TD. QB **RICH DOYLE** also played, completing 5 of 9 for 63 yards. Together, they connected with nine different receivers, led by WR **RYAN LIDRAZZAH's** six catches for 44 yards and a touchdown.

The Red Devils got on the board thanks to a Hobart fumble at the Statesmen 13. Three plays later, the score was tied, 7-7.

Dickinson grabbed the lead with 2:38 remaining in the first quarter on a four-play, 87-yard drive. QB Ian Mitchell's 74-yard run set up a 12-yard TD. The extra-point was blocked leaving the Red Devils a 13-7 edge.

The second quarter belonged to Hobart as RB **ANDREW MARLIER** scored on a 1-yard touchdown run and Strom hit LiDrazzah for a 28-yard strike. **DOMINICK ANCONA's** PATs found their mark sending the Statesmen into the break with a 21-13 lead.

Ancona accounted for the only points of the third quarter on a 41-yard field goal, the longest by a Hobart player since Sept. 24, 2005 (47 yds).

Late in the fourth quarter, Dickinson ended its nearly 45-minute scoring drought on an 8-yard touchdown run by Tim Smith (85 yds, 2 TD). The two-point conversion was no good, leaving Hobart a 24-19 lead.

Trailing by five with under a minute remaining, the Red Devils forced a fumble at their own 15. DB Will Scott scooped it up and returned it 86 yards for the go ahead TD with 47 seconds remaining. The two-point conversion put the Devils up 27-24.

From their own 18-yard line, Strom and Doyle completed a pair of passes each, moving the Statesmen into scoring range with one second remaining. Ancona's second career field goal attempt was true from 36 yards, forcing OT.

Hobart missed a 42-yard field goal attempt with the first series in OT and Dickinson's Matt Stark booted a 37-yard field goal to win it.

Defensively, Dickinson had five players record double digits in tackles, led by line-backer Eric Dube's 18 stops. ILB **JEFF SANDERS** paced the Statesmen with eight.

Sept. 15, 2007

GENEVA—The Statesmen upset 22nd-ranked Carnegie Mellon, 27-26. The Tartans had a chance to take the lead with 1:32 remaining, but missed a two-point conversion.

QB **ANDREW STROM** threw for 247 yards and three touchdowns, while rushing for a team-high 35 yards. WR **JAMES WRIGHT** was his top target, pulling in eight passes for 99 yards and two touchdowns.

Hobart posted its first lead of the game with 4:47 remaining when Strom completed an 11-play 63-yard drive with a toss to the back corner of the end zone that WR **RYAN LIDRAZZAH** collected. **DOMINICK ANCONA's** PAT put the Statesmen up 27-20.

Carnegie Mellon answered with an 11-play, 73-yard drive that ended with Sivek barreling in from 1 yard out. The Tartans opted to go for two, but failed as the pass was bobbled until the intended receiver was out of bounds. CMU attempted an onside kick, but Wright recovered for Hobart.

The Statesmen ran all but nine seconds off the game clock and iced the victory on FS **DAN PEMBROKE's** first career interception with no time remaining.

The defensive star of the game for Hobart was LB **JUSTIN HAGER**. He produced a team-high 19 tackles, the most by a Statesman since the start of the 1999 season. CB **JAMES ALEXANDER** also reached double digits with 11 stops. CB Jon Scholl paced the Tartans with a game-high 20 stops.

CMU jumped out to a 13-0 lead. At the 4:07 mark of the first quarter, Sivek ran in from 3 yards out and Colin Marks booted the point after for a 7-0 lead.

The Tartans made it 13-0 with 5:35 left in the second quarter on a 1-yard dive by Sivek. Marks PAT was wide, a result that had big repercussions later in the afternoon.

The second score lit a fire under the Hobart offense. The Statesmen answered with a six-play, 70-yard drive that ended with a 7-yard pass from Strom to Wright. Strom accounted for a pair of 20-yard gains on the drive, one with his feet and one with his arm.

The defense forced CMU to punt with 56 seconds left in the first half and Strom completed five straight passes to set up Ancona's 40-yard field goal as time expired.

Ancona tied the game 20-all with the only points of the third quarter, a 29-yard field goal with 1:45 left in the frame.

The teams traded touchdowns to start the fourth quarter, CMU on a 14-yard run by Gimson and Hobart on a 13-yard twisting reception by Wright, to set up the drama of the final minutes.
