SERIES SNAPSHOT—Hobart and St. Lawrence will meet for the 81st time today with the Statesmen leading the all-time series 42-36-2. Hobart won the first contest between the long-time rivals 10-0 in 1901. The Statesmen have won 16 consecutive showdowns with the Saints, including last season's 56-21 victory.

WHEN LAST WE MET—Last season, Hobart produced 506 yards of total offense, including a season-high 251 yards on the ground, en route to a 56-21 Liberty League win over St. Lawrence. The Statesmen dominated time of possession, holding on to the ball for 36 minutes, 16 seconds, while converting on 11 of 17 third downs. Hobart scored two touchdowns in each of the first two quarters to race out to a 28-0 halftime lead.

THE STREAK—Hobart has won 16 consecutive games against St. Lawrence, the longest active winning streak by the Statesmen over a single opponent. Hobart has scored an average of 32.6 points per game during the streak, while allowing just 10.8.

ALMOST THE MOST—Hobart has scored 1,362 points in the 80 previous meetings against St. Lawrence. The only opponent the Statesmen have scored more against is Rochester (1,363) and Hobart has played the Yellowjackets 100 times.

ON THE FLIP SIDE—St. Lawrence has scored 1,383 points in the series with Hobart. Only two opponents have tallied more points against the Statesmen, Union (1,620 in 91 gms) and Rochester (1,404 in 100 gms).

ABOUT LAST WEEK—Hobart improved to 3-0 with a 27-14 win over Susquehanna. The Statesmen led 20-0 at halftime and were never seriously challenged in the second half. Hobart scored twice in the first quarter on short drives set up by Crusader fumbles. Senior running back **ANTHONY HOBAICA** (80 yds rush, 24 rec) put the first points on the board with a 35-yard scamper, the Statesmen's longest scoring play of the season. Sophomore running back **ANDREW MARLIER** (97 rush, 3 rec) punched it in from 3-yards out for the second score. Hobaica's second TD, a 31-yard reception, gave Hobart its lead going into the break.

TOP TACKLER—For the third game in a row, senior linebacker **JUSTIN HAGER** led Hobart in tackles, producing 10 stops against Susquehanna. He also recorded his first sack of the season, forced and recovered a fumble, and broke up a pass. The effort earned Hager his second consecutive Liberty League Defensive Performer of the Week award.

THIS JUST-IN—Speaking of **JUSTIN HAGER**, he leads the Liberty League and ranks fourth in the nation in tackles per game (14.0). With 42 tackles through three games, he's on pace to log 126 tackles this season. That's 12 more than he recorded last season and only three shy of the season record set by **JESSE TRULEY '96** in 1995.

TOP PICK—Like his jersey number, **DRAKE WOODARD** is No. 1 in the Liberty League in interceptions. He is also tied for third in the nation in that category (1.0/g). Woodard had an interception in the season opener against Dickinson and two the following week at Carnegie Mellon. He's on pace to tie the Hobart season record (9), currently shared by **BILL PALMER '94** and **ERIC NEWSOME '01**.

MANY HAPPY RETURNS—Hobart leads the Liberty League and ranks 17th in the nation in punt return average (14.5 yds/ret). Junior **ZACH SCHULZ** leads the conference and is 14th in the nation with a 15.8 yard average, while senior **LANCE BOYINGTON** is second in the League and 22nd in the nation at 13.3 per return.

AIR DEFENSE—The Statesmen lead the Liberty League and rank 25th in the nation in pass defense. Hobart is allowing just 132 yards per game through the air, while registering five interceptions and 10 pass break ups.

LEAGUE LEADER—In addition to leading the conference in punt returns and pass defense, Hobart also sits atop the Liberty League in third down conversion (42.1%), kickoff coverage (14.5 yds/ret allowed), and passing touchdowns (7).

LEAGUE LEADER II—On the other sideline, St. Lawrence leads the Liberty League in sacks by (11), fewest penalty yards against (36.5/gm), opponent third down conversion (21.1%), pass attempts (147), and field goals attempted (7).

BALANCE IS THE KEY—Opposing defenses have little choice but to prepare for both the run and pass when facing Hobart. Of their 202 plays this season, the Statesmen have called 107 running plays and 95 passing plays.

POSITIVE TREND—Hobart has increased its rushing production in each of the past two weeks. After gaining 97 yards on the ground against Dickinson, the Statesmen picked up 122 yards at Carnegie Mellon and 221 yards vs. Susquehanna last weekend. The same trend holds true for Hobart's total offense (331-358-370).

NEGATIVE TREND—St. Lawrence's defense has given up more yards than the previous week in each of the past three games. The Saints allowed 113 yards against Johns Hopkins then 302 yards to Norwich, followed by a 317-yard performance by Alfred, and 420 yards to Merchant Marine last week.

PRESEASON HYPE—Senior linebacker **JUSTIN HAGER** was named a preseason second-team All-American by *Lindy's College Football Preview*. In his first season as a starter, Hager turned in a record-setting 2007 campaign. The second team D3football.com All-East selection recorded a season-high 19 tackles against Carnegie Mellon and at Rochester. Posting 11 tackles or more in six of the Statesmen's 11 games, Hager finished the year with 114 stops, the third highest single season total in Hobart history.

STATESMEN SUSTAIN SUCCESS—Including last year's 8-3 mark, the Hobart football team has posted 11 consecutive winning seasons, a program record. Prior to the current streak of sustained success, the benchmark for winning campaigns was eight, established by the Hobart teams of 1921 through 1928.

CONFERENCE CROWNS—Hobart earned a share of the 2007 Liberty League Championship thanks to the Statesmen's 30-14 win over Rochester, finishing with a 6-1 conference record. It's the seventh time since 1998 that Hobart has captured at least a share of the league title.

SECOND CENTURY—Now in their 115th varsity season, the Statesmen have made seven postseason appearances over the past eight seasons (6 NCAA bids, 1 ECAC Bowl). That's an impressive turnaround after earning just a single postseason invitation—an ECAC bowl bid that was turned down—in the program's first 100 seasons.

HE'S THE BOSS—Now in his 14th season, Head Coach **MIKE CRAGG** boasts a career record of 92-42. He has been named the Liberty League Coach of the Year four times and was the AFCA Regional Coach of the Year in 2002. Cragg is Hobart's all-time leader in wins and games coached (134) and is second in winning percentage (.687).

LENDING A HAND—Head Coach **MIKE CRAGG** is assisted by Offensive Coordinator **KEVIN DEWALL '00**, Defensive Coordinator **SCOTT YODER '01**, linebackers coach **AARON BACKHAUS '00**, receivers coach **JIM RYAN** (St. John Fisher '00), quarterbacks coach **JON DRACH** (Western Michigan '04), running backs coach **JOHN MANLEY** (Brockport '72), and defensive

2008 CAPTAINS—Hobart seniors **RICH DOYLE**, **MATT DULIBA**, and **JEFF SANDERS** were voted by their peers to serve as team captains this season.

SCOUTING THE SAINTS—St. Lawrence brings an 0-4 record into today's contest. The Saints are averaging 7.5 points per game, while allowing 26.0. The offense is averaging 276.2 yards per game (101.2 rush/175.0 pass). Quarterback J.P. Kearney (88-43-5) directs the offense, having thrown for 453 yards and two touchdowns. Receiver Ryan Cooney is his top target, hauling in 17 passes for 290 yards and a TD. On the ground, fullback Eric Jones has carried 36 times for 148 yards and a TD. Defensively, St. Lawrence is allowing 288.0 yards per game (124.0/164.0). Defensive tackle Gerard Bryant leads the team with 46 tackles and leads the nation with 14.0 tackles for a loss, including three sacks.

ON THE AIR—Every Hobart football game will be carried live by WEOS-FM (89.7/90.3 in Geneva, 88.1 in Ithaca). Veteran play-by-play man Ted Baker will describe all of the action.

GAME 1 • Hobart 28, Dickinson 21 Sept. 13, 2008

GENEVA—Hobart won its season opener 28-21 over visiting Dickinson. The Statesmen led 14-0 at halftime, but had to rally from a 21-14 deficit with two scores in the final four minutes for the victory. Hobart was outgained 405-331 offensively, but got the big plays when it needed it most.

The first half belonged to the Statesmen, who marched 65 yards on 12 plays for a touchdown on their first possession. RB **ANTHONY HOBAICA** capped the drive with a 3-yard scoring plunge.

FS **LANCE BOYINGTON** spoiled the Red Devils' best scoring chance of the first half, intercepting Ian Mitchell's pass into the end zone early in the second quarter.

Hobart doubled its lead with its final drive of the first half, moving 53 yards in 10 plays. QB **RICH DOYLE** hit WR **TYLER VINCENT** for 19 yards and the touchdown.

Mitchell was intercepted a second time to end the first half, as **CB DRAKE WOODARD** corralled the 36-yard heave as time expired. Hobart led 14-0 at the break.

The Red Devils broke through late in the third quarter on a 1-yard run by Greg Lord. The drive covered 62 yards in 12 plays. Early in the fourth quarter, Lord tied the game on a 2-yard run, capping an 11-play 62 yard drive.

Dickinson's defense forced Hobart to go three and out and used its next possession to take the lead. Mitchell hit WR Pat O'Connor on a short route. O'Connor used good blocking to go 20 yards to the end zone and a 21-14 lead.

The deficit jolted the Statesmen out of their second half slumber. Doyle found TE **MATT DULIBA** open up the middle for 31 yards and WR **ZACH SCHULZ** made a diving catch at the one for 38 more. Doyle finished the drive with a 1-yard keeper.

The Hobart defense also came to life, forcing the Red Devils to go three and out. The punt traveled just 12 yards to the Dickinson 47.

Six plays later, Doyle hit Schulz on a curl route for 16 yards and a touchdown. K **CONOR CALLAHAN** capped a perfect debut with his fourth successful PAT to give the Statesmen a 28-21 lead with 54 seconds left in regulation.

Mitchell moved the Red Devils down to the Hobart 25 with 9.4 seconds remaining. LB **JEFF SANDERS** broke up Dickinson's first shot at the tying score, leaving less than six seconds remaining. Boyington was the hero on second down, knocking what could have been a tying score out of the hands of O'Connor as time expired.

LB **JUSTIN HAGER** led the Hobart defense with a game-high 11 tackles, while DT **RYAN ARUCK** and Sanders each recorded 10 stops.

GAME 2 • Hobart 21, Carnegie Mellon 16 Sept. 20, 2008

PITTSBURGH—LB **JUSTIN HAGER** broke the game record for tackles, leading the Statesmen to a 21-16 victory at Carnegie Mellon. He posted 21 stops, two more than the previous mark.

LB **JEFF SANDERS** finished with 20 tackles, while DT **RYAN ARUCK** contributed 11 stops. CB **DRAKE WOODARD** logged two interceptions.

The Statesmen scored late in the first quarter when TE **MATT DULIBA** caught a 6-yard pass from QB **RICH DOYLE** with 3:42 remaining, completing a four-play, 57-yard drive that was set up by Woodard's first INT.

The pick was the start of either a superb defensive first half or a sloppy offensive first half, depending on one's perspective. CMU and Hobart combined to throw five first half interceptions, three by Doyle (27-14-3, 219 yds, 3 TDs) and two by Tartan Phil Pantalone (14-8-2, 102, 1).

CMU managed to break out of the funk just before halftime, engineering a 14-play, 89-yard drive that ended on a 20-yard pass from Pantalone to Ryan Phillips, 45 seconds before the intermission. The teams went into the locker room tied 7-all.

After both teams punted away their first two possessions of the second half, Hobart put up the only points of the third quarter. Doyle again found Duliba, this time from 5-yards out, to put the Statesmen in front 14-7 with 28 ticks left.

The Tartans responded with a game-tying drive, capped by a 2-yard dive by fullback Anthony Ruzga early in the fourth quarter.

On the next two drives, the teams traded punts, but Hobart won the field position battle. After three plays that netted just 1 yard to the CMU 11, Carnegie Mellon launched a 38-yard punt that **LANCE BOYINGTON** fielded at the CMU 49. Boyington's 15-yard return gave the Statesmen first and 10 from the 34. Doyle connected with WR **ZACH SCHULZ** on first down for all 34 yards and a 21-14 lead.

The Tartans responded by moving from their own 36 to the Hobart 5 in 12 plays with just over a minute remaining. Facing fourth down and two Pantalone's pass was broken up by Woodard.

Four plays later, Hobart took an intentional safety with 3 seconds to go rather than risk a blocked punt, accounting for the final points of the day.

RB **ANTHONY HOBAICA** rushed for a game-high 111 yards on 18 carries, marking the first time a Statesman has gained 100 yards on the ground since Nov. 11, 2006.

GAME 3 • Hobart 27, Susquehanna 14 Sept. 27, 2008

GENEVA—Hobart won its Liberty League opener 27-14 over Susquehanna. The Statesmen scored the first 20 points of the game.

Hobart gained 370 yards of offense, including a season-high 221 on the ground. RB **ANTHONY HOBAICA** led the way with 80 yards rushing and a touchdown as well as 24 yards receiving and another TD, while RB **ANDREW MARLIER** rushed for a team-high 97 yards and a touchdown.

Defensively, the Statesmen stymied the Crusaders, particularly in the first half. Susquehanna gained just 227 yards of offense (109 rush/118 pass). Before half-time, the visitors managed just two first downs, only 56 yards (53/3), and went 0 for 8 on third downs.

LB **JUSTIN HAGER** led Hobart with 10 tackles, a sack, a forced fumble, and a fumble recovery. DT **RYAN ARUCK** was close behind with nine stops, while LB **RYAN ROBINSON** chipped in seven tackles, an interception, and a forced fumble.

Hobart took advantage of a pair of first quarter fumbles to build a 13-0 lead. Robinson set up the first TD, knocking the ball out of RB Dave Paveletz's hands at the Crusaders' 28. Hager recovered for the Statesmen. Two plays later, Hobaica sprung free on Hobart's longest scoring play of the season, sprinting 35 yards to the end zone.

On the ensuing possession, Susquehanna QB Rich Palazzi was sacked by Hager, jarring the ball lose for DE **TONY GUIDETTI** to recover at the Crusaders' 35. Three plays later, Marlier punched it in from 3 yards out. The extra point was wide left leaving the Statesmen a 13-0 lead.

Hobart made it 20-0 late in the second half, using a 33-yard scramble by QB **RICH DOYLE** and a 31-yard completion from Doyle to Hobaica to cover the 64 yards to the end zone.

Susquehanna got on the board midway through the third quarter. Paveletz carried six times for 42 yards, including the final 7, on the 10-play, 83-yard drive.

The Statesmen answered midway through the fourth quarter when Doyle hit WR **GARTH MURATORI** for 10 yards and a TD, capping an 11-play, 49-yard march that ran 5:35 off the clock.

QB Derek Pope engineered the final scoring drive of the day. He completed 7-of-9 passes for 60 yards, the last 8 on SE J.J. Moran's scoring catch with 1:38 left. The Crusaders attempted an on-side kick, but the ball sailed out of bounds

untouched and Hobart ran out the clock.
