SERIES SNAPSHOT—Hobart and Susquehanna will square off for just the fourth time this afternoon with the Crusaders leading 2-1. Susquehanna won the first two meetings 35-6 in 1961 and 27-14 in 1966. The Statesmen won the most recent meeting 41-13 in 2007.

WHEN LAST WE MET—Last season, Hobart rolled up 599 yards of total offense in a 41-13 Liberty League win at Susquehanna. QB ANDREW STROM threw for a career-high 385 yards and four touchdowns to lead the Statesmen. Hobart scored the first 21 points of the game and answered the Crusaders' first touchdown with three more TDs. The Hobart defense turned in a stellar performance, forcing the Crusaders to punt on their first eight possessions. Susquehanna gained just three first downs and a scant 65 yards during the first half.

STRENGTH vs. STRENGTH—Something's got to give today. Hobart leads the Liberty League in punt return average (15.4 yds/ret), while Susquehanna leads the conference in punting (43.6 net yds/p). Junior ZACH **SCHULZ** is averaging a league best 19.5 yards per punt return for the Statesmen, while Crusader Bobby Eppleman is averaging 47.3 yards per punt.

ABOUT LAST WEEK—Hobart improved to 2-0 with a 21-16 win at Carnegie Mellon. Senior quarterback RICH DOYLE (27-14-3) threw for 219 yards and three touchdowns. Junior wideout ZACH SCHULZ scored the final TD of the day on a 34-yard pass from Doyle to put the Statesmen in front 21-14 midway through the fourth quarter. The Tartans responded by moving from their own 36 to the Hobart 5 in 12 plays with just over a minute remaining. Facing fourth down and 2, CMU's pass play was broken up by first-year cornerback DRAKE WOODARD.

TWENTY-ONE—Senior inside linebacker JUSTIN **HAGER** broke the Hobart single game record for tackles with 21 stops at Carnegie Mellon and was named the Liberty League and ECAC Upstate Defensive Player of the Week. JESSE TRULEY '95 established the previous mark with 19 against Dickinson in 1995. In 2007, Hager twice tied Truley's mark, first against the Tartans and again at Rochester.

LEAGUE LEADER—Speaking of JUSTIN HAGER, he leads the conference and ranks second in the nation in tackles, averaging 16 stops through the first two games. Only two players in the League have more total tackles than Hager's 32, and they've both played in one more game. In 30 career games, Hager has 186 tackles.

SO CLOSE—On Saturday at Carnegie Mellon, senior inside linebacker **JEFF SANDERS** also broke the Hobart single game record for tackles with 20 stops. The total is double his previous career-high. Sanders is second in the conference and tied for fifth in the nation at 15.0 tackles per game.

ARUCK and senior linebacker JEFF SANDERS joined an elite group of Statesmen on Saturday. With 11 and 20 tackles, respectively, they both recorded their 200th career tackles. The two became the 16th and 17th Statesmen since the start of the 1985 season to reach that plateau. Sanders is now 14th with 210, 12 behind No. 11 JARROD KREMBLAS '96, while Aruck is tied for 16th with RICH BARLETTE '01 at 201, one shy of No. 15 JESSE TRULEY '96. Assistant Coach AARON BACKHAUS '00 sits atop the list with 279. The career record belongs to TOM ROSA '86, who had 393, but Hobart's complete season-by-season statistics only go back to 1985.

ON THE RUN—Senior tailback ANTHONY HOBAICA rushed for a game-high 111 yards at Carnegie Mellon. He's the first Statesman to gain 100-plus yards since Nov. 11, 2006 (118, DOUG BLAKOWSKI '07 at Rochester), while his 6.2 yards per carry average is the highest for a Statesman since Oct. 14, 2006 (7.6, Blakowski at Merchant Marine). Hobaica's efforts earned him the Liberty League Offensive Performer of the Week award. He ranks third in the conference in rushing (91.5 yds/g).

DRE'S DAY—First-year corner back **DRAKE WOO- DARD**, Dre to his teammates, earned his second consecutive Liberty League Rookie of the Week award

after posting three tackles, two interceptions and a pass break up at CMU. He ended consecutive Tartan drives in the second quarter with interceptions and broke up CMU's pass on fourth and 2 from the Hobart 5 to foil the hosts' final bid to tie the game. Woodard is tied for third in the nation in interceptions and tied for 19th in passes defended (interceptions plus pass break ups).

LONG RANGE FORECAST—Speaking of **DRAKE WOODARD**, he's the only player in the conference with more than one interception this season. With seven games remaining, he's already a third of the way to Hobart's single season record (9 shared by **BILL PALMER '94** and **ERIC NEWSOME '01**).

BALANCE IS THE KEY—Opposing defenses have little choice but to prepare for both the run and pass when facing Hobart. Of their 122 plays this season, the Statesmen have called 59 running plays and 63 passing plays.

EARLY RETURNS—While its still early, Hobart leads the Liberty League in four offensive categories: passing yards (235.0), pass efficiency (146.5), third down conversion percentage (47.8%), and passing yards per attempt (8.1).

PUTTING THE FOOT IN FOOTBALL—First-year **CONOR CALLAHAN** is off to a perfect start kicking PATs. He made all four of his extra points against Dickinson and all three of his PATs at Carnegie Mellon. Callahan is tied for the League lead in PAT percentage.

PRESEASON HYPE—Senior linebacker **JUSTIN HAGER** was named a preseason second-team All-American by *Lindy's College Football Preview*. In his first season as a starter, Hager turned in a record-setting 2007 campaign. The second team D3football.com All-East selec-

tion recorded a season-high 19 tackles against Carnegie Mellon and at Rochester. Posting 11 tackles or more in six of the Statesmen's 11 games, Hager finished the year with 114 stops, the third highest single season total in Hobart history.

STATESMEN SUSTAIN SUCCESS—Including last year's 8-3 mark, the Hobart football team has posted 11 consecutive winning seasons, a program record. Prior to the current streak of sustained success, the benchmark for winning campaigns was eight, established by the Hobart teams of 1921 through 1928.

CONFERENCE CROWNS—Hobart earned a share of the 2007 Liberty League Championship thanks to the Statesmen's 30-14 win over Rochester, finishing with a 6-1 conference record. It's the seventh time since 1998 that Hobart has captured at least a share of the league title.

SECOND CENTURY—Now in their 115th varsity season, the Statesmen have made seven postseason appearances over the past eight seasons (6 NCAA bids, 1 ECAC Bowl). That's an impressive turnaround after earning just a single postseason invitation—an ECAC bowl bid that was turned down—in the program's first 100 seasons.

HE'S THE BOSS—Now in his 14th season, Head Coach **MIKE CRAGG** boasts a career record of 91-42. He has been named the Liberty League Coach of the Year four times and was the AFCA Regional Coach of the Year in 2002. Cragg is Hobart's all-time leader in wins and games coached (133) and is second in winning percentage (.684).

LENDING A HAND—Head Coach **MIKE CRAGG** is assisted by Offensive Coordinator **KEVIN DEWALL '00**, Defensive Coordinator **SCOTT YODER '01**, linebackers coach **AARON BACK-HAUS '00**, receivers coach **JIM RYAN** (St. John Fisher '00), quarterbacks coach **JON DRACH** (Western Michigan '04), running backs coach **JOHN MANLEY** (Brockport '72), and defensive line coach **TERRY MUFFLEY** (East Stroudsburg '74).

2008 CAPTAINS—Hobart seniors **RICH DOYLE**, **MATT DULIBA**, and **JEFF SANDERS** were voted by their peers to serve as team captains this season.

SCOUTING THE CRUSADERS—Susquehanna brings a 1-2 record to Boswell Field, losing to Moravian 27-14, defeating Juniata 10-3, and falling to Lycoming 28-16. The Crusaders are averaging 13.3 points per game while allowing 19.3. Offensively, Susquehanna is gaining 225 yards per game (95.7 rush/129.3 pass). Junior running back Dave Paveletz leads the ground game, averaging 87 yards per game. First-year quarterback Rich Palazzi (24-14-0, 103 yds) is listed as the Crusaders' starter, having wrestled the job away from senior Derek Pope (64-29-4, 285 yds, 2 TD). Junior Justin Young is the team's top receiver with nine receptions for 116 yards and 2 TDs. Defensively, the Crusaders are allowing 367 yards (184/183). First-year linebacker Mitch Phillips leads the team with 35 tackles and ranks 34th in the nation, averaging 11.67 stops per game. On special teams, sophomore Bobby Eppleman leads the nation, averaging 47.29 yards per punt.

NEGATIVE CAMPAIGN—The Susquehanna defense is 14th in the nation in tackles for a loss, averaging 9.67 per game. The Crusader offense has done a good job of avoiding negative plays, ranking 25th in the nation with just 4.0 plays per game that lose yardage.

ON THE AIR—Every Hobart football game will be carried live by WEOS-FM (89.7/90.3 in Geneva, 88.1 in Ithaca). Veteran play-by-play man Ted Baker will describe all of the action.

UP NEXT—Hobart heads back out on the road, visiting St. Lawrence on Oct. 4. The Statesmen and Saints will kickoff at 1 p.m. Hobart has won 16 in a row against St. Lawrence and leads the all-time series 42-36-2.

GAME 1 • Hobart 28, Dickinson 21 Sept. 13, 2008

GENEVA—Hobart won its season opener 28-21 over visiting Dickinson. The Statesmen led 14-0 at halftime, but had to rally from a 21-14 deficit with two scores in the final four minutes for the victory. Hobart was outgained 405-331 offensively, but got the big plays when it needed it most.

The first half belonged to the Statesmen, who marched 65 yards on 12 plays for a touchdown on their first possession. RB **ANTHONY HOBAICA** capped the drive with a 3-yard scoring plunge.

FS LANCE BOYINGTON spoiled the Red Devils' best scoring chance of the first half, intercepting Ian Mitchell's pass into the end zone early in the second quarter.

Hobart doubled its lead with its final drive of the first half, moving 53 yards in 10 plays. QB **RICH DOYLE** hit WR **TYLER VINCENT** for 19 yards and the touchdown.

Mitchell was intercepted a second time to end the first half, as CB DRAKE WO-ODARD corralled the 36-yard heave as time expired. Hobart led 14-0 at the break.

The Red Devils broke through late in the third quarter on a 1-yard run by Greg Lord. The drive covered 62 yards in 12 plays. Early in the fourth quarter, Lord tied the game on a 2-yard run, capping an 11-play 62 yard drive.

Dickinson's defense forced Hobart to go three and out and used its next possession to take the lead. Mitchell hit WR Pat O'Connor on a short route. O'Connor used good blocking to go 20 yards to the end zone and a 21-14 lead.

The deficit jolted the Statesmen out of their second half slumber. Doyle found TE MATT DULIBA open up the middle for 31 yards and WR ZACH SCHULZ made a diving catch at the one for 38 more. Doyle finished the drive with a 1-yard keeper.

The Hobart defense also came to life, forcing the Red Devils to go three and out. The punt traveled just 12 yards to the Dickinson 47.

Six plays later, Doyle hit Schulz on a curl route for 16 yards and a touchdown. K **CONOR CALLAHAN** capped a perfect debut with his fourth successful PAT to give the Statesmen a 28-21 lead with 54 seconds left in regulation.

Mitchell moved the Red Devils down to the Hobart 25 with 9.4 seconds remaining. LB JEFF SANDERS broke up Dickinson's first shot at the tying score, leaving less than six seconds remaining. Boyington was the hero on second down, knocking what could have by a tying score out of the hands of O'Connor as time expired.

LB JUSTIN HAGER led the Hobart defense with a game-high 11 tackles, while DT RYAN ARUCK and Sanders each recorded 10 stops.

GAME 2 • Hobart 21, Carnegie Mellon 16 Sept. 20, 2008

PITTSBURGH—LB **JUSTIN HAGER** broke the game record for tackles, leading the Statesmen to a 21-16 victory at Carnegie Mellon. He posted 21 stops, two more than the previous mark.

LB JEFF SANDERS finished with 20 tackles, while DT RYAN ARUCK contributed 11 stops. CB DRAKE WOODARD logged two interceptions.

The Statesmen scored late in the first quarter when **TE MATT DULIBA** caught a 6-yard pass from QB **RICH DOYLE** with 3:42 remaining, completing a four-play, 57-yard drive that was set up by Woodard's first INT.

The pick was the start of either a superb defensive first half or a sloppy offensive first half, depending on one's perspective. CMU and Hobart combined to throw five first half interceptions, three by Doyle (27-14-3, 219 yds, 3 TDs) and two by Tartan Phil Pantalone (14-8-2, 102, 1).

CMU managed to break out of the funk just before halftime, engineering a 14-play, 89-yard drive that ended on a 20-yard pass from Pantalone to Ryan Phillips, 45 seconds before the intermission. The teams went into the locker room tied 7-all.

After both teams punted away their first two possessions of the second half, Hobart put up the only points of the third quarter. Doyle again found Duliba, this time from 5-yards out, to put the Statesmen in front 14-7 with 28 ticks left.

The Tartans responded with a game-tying drive, capped by a 2-yard dive by fullback Anthony Ruzga early in the fourth quarter.

On the next two drives, the teams traded punts, but Hobart won the field position battle. After three plays that netted just 1 yard to the CMU 11, Carnegie Mellon launched a 38-yard punt that **LANCE BOYINGTON** fielded at the CMU 49. Boyington's 15-yard return gave the Statesmen first and 10 from the 34. Doyle connected with WR **ZACH SCHULZ** on first down for all 34 yards and a 21-14 lead.

The Tartans responded by moving from their own 36 to the Hobart 5 in 12 plays with just over a minute remaining. Facing fourth down and two Pantalone's pass was broken up by Woodard.

Four plays later, Hobart took an intentional safety with 3 seconds to go rather than risk a blocked punt, accounting for the final points of the day.

RB ANTHONY HOBAICA rushed for a game-high 111 yards on 18 carries, marking the first time a Statesman has gained 100 yards on the ground since Nov. 11, 2006.
