GAME 7 • WPI (6-1, 3-1) at HOBART (5-1, 3-1)

SERIES SNAPSHOT—Today's game between the Statesmen and Engineers marks the fifth meeting between the schools with Hobart holding a 4-0 series lead. The Statesmen have outscored WPI 143-94, but have averaged just a 7.5 point cushion over the past two seasons.

ABOUT LAST WEEK—Hobart shut out Merchant Marine 24-0. The Statesmen defense allowed just 46 yards of total offense, while the offense racked up 352 yards.

NO GAIN—MMA's zero rushing yards are the lowest total for a Hobart opponent since Oct. 15, 2005, when the Statesmen used six sacks to force the Mariners into minus 10 yards rushing. Since 1992, only four Hobart opponents have failed to gain at least 100 total yards and all three of the previous futile efforts produced at least 71 yards.

TIME IS ON OUR SIDE—Hobart dominated time of possession at Merchant Marine. The Statesmen held on to the ball for an amazing 43 minutes, 37 seconds. Since 1999, Hobart's widest margin in TOP was 19:48 (St. Lawrence 2006), but the Statesmen obliterated that mark, boasting a margin of 27:14 against the Mariners. The Academy managed just five first downs and converted only two of 12 third downs.

JUST FOR KICKS—In his first game as a collegiate kicker, junior **P.J. OVERDORF** made all three of his PATs and booted a 29-yard field goal against the Mariners, earning the Liberty League Special Teams Player of the Week award. The quarterback turned wide receiver was pressed into kicking duties due to injuries. Overdorf also handled the punting duties, averaging 34.4 yards with a long of 56, while dropping one inside the Mariners' 20.

TOP TACKLER—Hobart's top tackler in each of the season's first five contests has been senior linebacker **JUSTIN HAGER**. In fact, he's led the Statesmen in tackles in 11 consecutive games dating back to last season.

WHEN LAST WE MET—Sept. 29, 2007

WORCESTER, Mass.—Hobart scored on five consecutive possessions in the first half, but it was a pair of second half rushing touchdowns by RB ANTHONY HOBAICA that put the Statesmen up by 17 on their way to a 45-35 win over WPI. Hobart DE KWAME LOVELL counted three sacks among his team-high seven tackles.

Hager's on pace to log 115 tackles this season. That's one more than he recorded last season and 14 shy of the season record set by **JESSE TRULEY** '96 in 1995.

THIRD TIME'S A CHARM—Senior **JUSTIN HAGER** has earned three Liberty League weekly awards this season. Hager has been tabbed the Defensive Performer of the Week following three of Hobart's past five games.

TOP PICK—Like his jersey number, **DRAKE WOODARD** is No. 1 in the nation in interceptions. He has six picks this year, recording two in each of Hobart's first two road games this season. Woodard's on pace to tie the Hobart season record (9) currently shared by **BILL PALMER '94** and **ERIC NEWSOME '01**.

ANOTHER AWARD WINNING PERFORMANCE—Although he didn't have any interceptions at Merchant Marine, **DRAKE WOODARD** still picked up his fourth Liberty League Rookie of the Week award. He scored a touchdown by recovering a blocked punt in the end zone and notched a tackle for a loss.

AIR DEFENSE—The Statesmen lead the Liberty League in pass defense and pass efficiency defense. Opponents are averaging just 123.8 yards per game through the air, fourth in the nation. Opposing quarterbacks have an efficiency rating of just 81.98 against Hobart, also fourth in the nation.

BIG PLAYS—Hobart has averaged 5.7 "big plays" (20 yards or more) per game. Junior **ZACH SCHULZ** has been involved in a team-high seven big plays. Senior quarterback **RICH DOYLE's** 52-yard completion to junior wideout **TYLER VINCENT** against Union is the team's longest play of the season. Senior running back **ANTHONY HOBAICA's** 35-yard touchdown run against Susquehanna is the Statesmen's longest scoring play of the year.

HE'S THE BOSS—Now in his 14th season, Head Coach **MIKE CRAGG** boasts a career record of 94-42. He has been named the Liberty League Coach of the Year four times and was the AFCA Regional Coach of the Year in 2002. Cragg is Hobart's all-time leader in wins and games coached (136) and is second in winning percentage (.691).

SCOUTING THE ENGINEERS—WPI brings a 6-1 overall record to Boswell Field, including a 3-1 mark in the Liberty League. The Engineers are averaging 25.2 points, while allowing 16.5. The offense is gaining 376.4 yards per game (148.4 rush/228.0 pass). Senior quarterback Justin Wells directs the passing attack, completing 57.7 percent of his passes for 1,416 yards and seven touchdowns. Junior wideouts Cody McGregor (39 rec, 462 yds, 2 TD) and R.C. Grady (38, 628, 3) are his primary targets. Six different Engineers, led by sophomore running back Manny Cambra, have carried at least 10 times this season. Cambra has 302 yards and five TDs, while Wells sports a team-high seven rushing touchdowns. Defensively, WPI is allowing 271.3 yards per game (88.1/183.1). Senior linebacker Stefan Nicotra leads the way with 67 tackles (46 solo), while senior defensive lineman Justin Thomas counts five sacks among his 29 tackles.

ON THE AIR—Every Hobart football game will be carried live by WEOS-FM (89.7/90.3 in Geneva, 88.1 in Ithaca). Veteran play-by-play man Ted Baker will describe all of the action.

GAME 1 • Hobart 28, Dickinson 21 Sept. 13, 2008

GENEVA—Hobart won its season opener 28-21 over visiting Dickinson. The Statesmen led 14-0 at halftime, but had to rally from a 21-14 deficit with two scores in the final four minutes for the victory. Hobart was outgained 405-331 offensively, but got the big plays when it needed it most.

The first half belonged to the Statesmen, who marched 65 yards on 12 plays for a touchdown on their first possession. RB **ANTHONY HOBAICA** capped the drive with a 3-yard scoring plunge.

FS LANCE BOYINGTON spoiled the Red Devils' best scoring chance of the first half, intercepting Ian Mitchell's pass into the end zone early in the second quarter.

Hobart doubled its lead with its final drive of the first half, moving 53 yards in 10 plays. QB **RICH DOYLE** hit WR **TYLER VINCENT** for 19 yards and the touchdown.

Mitchell was intercepted a second time to end the first half, as **CB DRAKE WO-ODARD** corralled the 36-yard heave as time expired. Hobart led 14-0 at the break.

The Red Devils broke through late in the third quarter on a 1-yard run by Greg Lord. The drive covered 62 yards in 12 plays. Early in the fourth quarter, Lord tied the game on a 2-yard run, capping an 11-play 62 yard drive.

Dickinson's defense forced Hobart to go three and out and used its next possession to take the lead. Mitchell hit WR Pat O'Connor on a short route. O'Connor used good blocking to go 20 yards to the end zone and a 21-14 lead.

The deficit jolted the Statesmen out of their second half slumber. Doyle found TE **MATT DULIBA** open up the middle for 31 yards and WR **ZACH SCHULZ** made a diving catch at the one for 38 more. Doyle finished the drive with a 1-yard keeper.

The Hobart defense also came to life, forcing the Red Devils to go three and out. The punt traveled just 12 yards to the Dickinson 47.

Six plays later, Doyle hit Schulz on a curl route for 16 yards and a touchdown. K **CONOR CALLAHAN** capped a perfect debut with his fourth successful PAT to give the Statesmen a 28-21 lead with 54 seconds left in regulation.

Mitchell moved the Red Devils down to the Hobart 25 with 9.4 seconds remaining. LB **JEFF SANDERS** broke up Dickinson's first shot at the tying score, leaving less than six seconds remaining. Boyington was the hero on second down, knocking what could have by a tying score out of the hands of O'Connor as time expired.

LB JUSTIN HAGER led the Hobart defense with a game-high 11 tackles, while DT RYAN ARUCK and Sanders each recorded 10 stops.

GAME 2 • Hobart 21, Carnegie Mellon 16 Sept. 20, 2008

PITTSBURGH—LB **JUSTIN HAGER** broke the game record for tackles, leading the Statesmen to a 21-16 victory at Carnegie Mellon. He posted 21 stops, two more than the previous mark.

LB JEFF SANDERS finished with 20 tackles, while DT RYAN ARUCK contributed 11 stops. CB DRAKE WOODARD logged two interceptions.

The Statesmen scored late in the first quarter when **TE MATT DULIBA** caught a 6-yard pass from QB **RICH DOYLE** with 3:42 remaining, completing a four-play, 57-yard drive that was set up by Woodard's first INT.

The pick was the start of either a superb defensive first half or a sloppy offensive first half, depending on one's perspective. CMU and Hobart combined to throw five first half interceptions, three by Doyle (27-14-3, 219 yds, 3 TDs) and two by Tartan Phil Pantalone (14-8-2, 102, 1).

CMU managed to break out of the funk just before halftime, engineering a 14play, 89-yard drive that ended on a 20-yard pass from Pantalone to Ryan Phillips, 45 seconds before the intermission. The teams went into the locker room tied 7-all.

After both teams punted away their first two possessions of the second half, Hobart put up the only points of the third quarter. Doyle again found Duliba, this time from 5-yards out, to put the Statesmen in front 14-7 with 28 ticks left.

The Tartans responded with a game-tying drive, capped by a 2-yard dive by fullback Anthony Ruzga early in the fourth quarter.

On the next two drives, the teams traded punts, but Hobart won the field position battle. After three plays that netted just 1 yard to the CMU 11, Carnegie Mellon launched a 38-yard punt that **LANCE BOYINGTON** fielded at the CMU 49. Boyington's 15-yard return gave the Statesmen first and 10 from the 34. Doyle connected with WR **ZACH SCHULZ** on first down for all 34 yards and a 21-14 lead.

The Tartans responded by moving from their own 36 to the Hobart 5 in 12 plays with just over a minute remaining. Facing fourth down and two Pantalone's pass was broken up by Woodard.

Four plays later, Hobart took an intentional safety with 3 seconds to go rather than risk a blocked punt, accounting for the final points of the day.

RB ANTHONY HOBAICA rushed for a game-high 111 yards on 18 carries, marking the first time a Statesman has gained 100 yards on the ground since Nov. 11, 2006.

GAME 3 • Hobart 27, Susquehanna 14 Sept. 27, 2008

GENEVA—Hobart won its Liberty League opener 27-14 over Susquehanna. The Statesmen scored the first 20 points of the game.

Hobart gained 370 yards of offense, including a season-high 221 on the ground. RB **ANTHONY HOBAICA** led the way with 80 yards rushing and a touchdown as well as 24 yards receiving and another TD, while RB **ANDREW MARLIER** rushed for a team-high 97 yards and a touchdown.

Defensively, the Statesmen stymied the Crusaders, particularly in the first half. Susquehanna gained just 227 yards of offense. Before halftime, the visitors managed just two first downs, only 56 yards, and went 0 for 8 on third downs.

LB JUSTIN HAGER led Hobart with 10 tackles, a sack, a forced fumble, and a fumble recovery. DT RYAN ARUCK was close behind with nine stops, while LB RYAN ROBINSON chipped in seven tackles, an interception, and a forced fumble.

Hobart took advantage of a pair of first quarter fumbles to build a 13-0 lead. Robinson set up the first TD, knocking the ball out of RB Dave Paveletz's hands at the Crusaders' 28. Hager recovered for the Statesmen. Two players later, Hobaica sprung free on Hobart's longest scoring play of the season, sprinting 35 yards to the end zone.

On the ensuing possession, Susquehanna QB Rich Palazzi was sacked by Hager, jarring the ball lose for DE **TONY GUIDETTI** to recover at the Crusaders' 35. Three plays later, Marlier punched it in from 3 yards out. The extra point was wide left leaving the Statesmen a 13-0 lead.

Hobart made it 20-0 late in the second half, using a 33-yard scramble by QB **RICH DOYLE** and a 31-yard completion from Doyle to Hobaica to cover the 64 yards to the end zone.

Susquehanna got on the board midway through the third quarter. Paveletz carried six times for 42 yards, including the final 7, on the 10-play, 83-yard drive.

The Statesmen answered midway through the fourth quarter when Doyle hit WR **GARTH MURATORI** for 10 yards and a TD, capping an 11-play, 49-yard march that ran 5:35 off the clock.

QB Derek Pope engineered the final scoring drive of the day. He completed 7-of-9 passes for 60 yards, the last 8 on SE J.J. Moran's scoring catch with 1:38 left. The Crusaders attempted an on-side kick, but the ball sailed out of bounds untouched and Hobart ran out the clock.

GAME 4 • Hobart 16, St. Lawrence 10 Oct. 4, 2008

CANTON—The Statesmen leaned on their defense in a 16-10 victory over St. Lawrence. LB **JUSTIN HAGER** led Hobart to its 17th consecutive win over the Saints with a game-high 13 tackles.

The Statesmen struggled to move the football in the first quarter, punting on their first three possessions, but the Saints struggled just as much.

CB CHRIS SZYMANSKI stopped SLU's first drive with an interception at the Hobart 20. After the Saints punted on their second possession, CB DRAKE WOO-DARD stopped St. Lawrence's third drive with an interception at the Hobart 27.

SLU opened the scoring early in the second quarter when QB J.P. Kearney capped an 11-play, 63-yard drive with a 1-yard keeper. The extra point gave the Saints a 7-0 lead. The Statesmen answered with their first scoring drive. From 28 yards out, K CONOR CALLAHAN booted his first career field goal to make it 7-3.

St. Lawrence was on its way to marching back down the field for another score when DE **TONY GUIDETTI** sacked Kearney for a 14-yard loss on third and 7 from the Hobart 25, pushing the Saints out of field goal range.

The Hobart offense solved its first half struggles with its first drive of the second half. Hobart moved 66 yards in just four plays, capped by an 11-yard scoring run by RB **ANTHONY HOBAICA**, to take a 9-7 lead. The extra point was no good. The Statesmen padded the lead late in the third quarter when RB **ANDREW MARLIER** scored on a 20-vard touchdown run. Callahan's PAT gave Hobart a 16-7 advantage.

Meanwhile, St. Lawrence struggled after the break, punting twice and watching a third drive die at the hands of Woodard, who, midway through the frame, registered his league-leading fifth interception of the season.

The Saints mounted the final scoring drive of the contest, booting a 26-yard field goal with 11:54 remaining.

Hobart punted—a career-long 53-yarder by P **TYLER VINCENT**—and had a 31yard field goal blocked with its final two possessions, but the defense made sure St. Lawrence got no closer.

Vincent's boomer pinned the Saints at their own 8. SLU managed just one first down before punting. On the Saints' final drive, they gained another first down, but on third and 11 from their own 45 LB **RYAN ROBINSON** streaked into the backfield to drop Kearney for a sack and a 12 yard loss and St. Lawrence was force to punt again. Hobart gained two first downs and ran the final 2:57 off the clock.

GAME 5 • Union 38, Hobart 35 Oct. 11, 2008

GENEVA—Hobart's four-game winning streak came to an end when Union kicked a field goal with 16.5 seconds remaining to secure a 38-35 win. Ben Rapple booted the game-winner after missing from 22 yards in the first quarter.

The Statesmen outgained the Dutchmen with a season-high 456 yards to 391, but missed all three of their field goal attempts (34, 36, and 23 yards) and turned the ball over on downs on a fourth trip inside the red zone, all in the first half.

Hobart struck first when QB **DOUG VELLA**, from 3 yards out, scored his first career touchdown to cap an eight-play, 61-yard drive, giving Hobart a 7-0 lead. The Dutchmen equalized when RB Chris Coney broke free on a 51-yard run, evening the score 3:45 before the break. Fifty-nine seconds before the half, WR **TYLER VIN-CENT** hauled in a 10 yard throw from QB **RICH DOYLE** to put the Statesmen back in front, 14-7. Kevin Valenti returned the ensuing kickoff 34 yards to midfield to set the table for QB Andrew Connolly's 22-yard heave to WR Justin Gallo in the back of the end zone nine seconds before the half expired.

Hobart reclaimed the lead with the first possession of the second half, marching 66 yards in 12 plays, as Doyle dove in from 1-yard out to give the Statesmen a 21-14 lead. Jared Gourrier collected an 11-yard pass from Connolly late in the frame to finish off a nine-play 48 yard drive and tie the game again.

Union took its first lead of the day early in the fourth quarter when Coney scored on a 1-yard dive. Hobart countered with a 10-play, 71-yard drive that Doyle capped with another 1-yard keeper with 10:30 remaining. The key play of the drive was a fake punt that Vincent turned into a 29-yard rush.

After trading punts, the Dutchmen mounted their final TD drive on the back of Coney, who carried on all four plays. He rattled off 57 yards on first down with CB **DRAKE WOODARD** tracking him down to delay the touchdown. Three plays later, Coney notched another 1 yard TD to give Union a 35-28 lead.

Once again, the Statesmen mounted a tying drive. Vincent pulled in an 8-yard toss from Doyle with 4:01 remaining deadlocking the game for the fifth time.

John Johnson returned the ensuing kickoff 43 yards to the Hobart 35. A pass interference penalty against Hobart on third and 5 from the 30, kept the Union offense on the field setting the stage for Rapple's game-winner.

LB JUSTIN HAGER recorded a game-high 15 tackles. Woodard made a careerhigh nine tackles and notched his league-leading sixth interception.

GAME 6 • Hobart 24, Merchant Marine 0 Oct. 25, 2008

KINGS POINT—The Statesmen posted their first shutout since 2005 with a 24-0 Liberty League win at the Merchant Marine. The Hobart defense limited the Mariners to just 46 yards of total offense, including zero rushing yards.

MMA's rushing total is the lowest for a Hobart opponent since Oct. 15, 2005, when the Statesmen used six sacks to force the Mariners into minus 10 yards rushing. Since 1992, only four Hobart opponents have failed to gain at least 100 total yards and all three of the previous futile efforts produced at least 71 yards.

On offense, Hobart ran a season-high 84 plays from scrimmage, gaining a season-high 231 yards on the ground. RB **ANTHONY HOBAICA** led the way with 83 yards, while RB **ANDREW MARLIER** added 68 yards and a touchdown. In all, seven different Statesmen ran the ball on the day.

Hobart fumbled the opening kickoff, setting the Mariners up at the Hobart 30. Four plays later, the Academy attempted a 34 yard field goal that was blocked by **LANCE BOYINGTON**. After the Statesmen's first drive sputtered deep in their own end due to a holding penalty, **P.J. OVERDORF's** 56-yard punt was downed at the Merchant Marine 7. The Mariners tried a deep pass on first down, but Boyington made his second interception of the season to kill another drive.

Hobart posted its first points on the second quarter's first possession. Overdorf capped a 14-play drive with a 29-yard field goal. MMA gained just two yards on the ensuing drive and lined up to punt, but **KEVIN GROGAN** blocked the attempt and **DRAKE WOODARD** recovered the loose ball in the end zone for a touchdown. Overdorf's extra point sent the Statesmen into halftime with a 10-0 lead.

The third quarter, like the first, was scoreless, but Hobart's dominance was apparent on the stat sheet. The Statesmen held on to the ball for 11 minutes, 17 seconds, running 21 plays and gaining 69 yards, while the Mariners were limited to just nine plays that picked up 17 yards.

Hobart found the end zone on its first drive of the fourth quarter when Marlier ran up the middle for 7 yards and a TD, capping an 8-play, 40-yard drive.

LB JEFF SANDERS' set up the Statesmen's final score, notching his first interception of the season at the Hobart 36. Ten plays later, WR ZACH SCHULZ (5 rec, 56 yds) pulled in a pass from QB RICH DOYLE (21-11-0, 121 yds) for a 24-0 lead with 4:55 remaining.
