GAME 27 • #7 HOBART (19-7-0) at #3 NORWICH (22-4-2)

TODAY'S GAME: Hobart and Norwich will square off for just the second time. The first meeting was also in the NCAA quarterfinals. The Cadets won that contest 9-5 in Kreitzberg Arena in 2004.

HOW WE GOT HERE: Hobart received one of three Pool C bids into the 10-team NCAA Tournament field after completing the regular season with a 19-7-0 overall record. Norwich (22-4-2) received one of six automatic bids after securing the ECAC East Championship.

NCAA HISTORY: Hobart is making its second appearance in the NCAA Tournament. In 2004, the Statesmen overcame an early four-goal deficit to take a 5-4 lead with 16:32 remaining in the contest, but Norwich rattled off five consecutive goals to halt Hobart's seven-game winning streak, 9-5.

UNCHARTED TERRITORY: The Statesmen boast 19 wins this season, four more than any previous Hobart squad. The previous standard for wins in a season was 15, established by the 1978-79 squad (15-16-1) and matched by the 2003-04 Statesmen (15-8-5). In fact, the program's success is even more impressive when you consider that between the 1993-94 and 2000-01 seasons, the Statesmen failed to win 19 games in any two years combined.

POLL SITTERS: Hobart is ranked seventh in the latest edition of the USCHO.com poll. After breaking into the top-10 on Dec. 5, 2005, the Statesmen have spent 11 consecutive weeks among the nation's elite teams, climbing as high as fifth (Feb. 13), the highest ranking in the program's history.

STREAKING: Hobart set a school record with eight consecutive wins between Nov. 12, 2005 and Dec. 10, 2005. The previous mark was seven straight from Feb. 6, 2004 through March 6, 2004.

STREAKING, II: Prior to Head Coach **MARK TAYLOR's** arrival in 2000, the Statesmen had never posted consecutive winning seasons. The 2005-06 season marks Hobart's fourth winning season in a row.

TOP HONORS: Head Coach MARK TAYLOR was named the ECAC West Coach of the Year for the third time in four seasons. He boasts a career record of 78-62-15 (.552), including a 62-31-11 (.649) mark over the past four seasons.

ALL-LEAGUE: Four Statesmen were selected to the All-ECAC West teams. Senior defenseman **GREG GALLAGHER** earned a place on the first team, while senior forwards **COLBY McVEY** and **ED POIRIER** represented Hobart on the second team. First-year goaltender **KEITH LONGO** was named to the All-Rookie Team.

RECORD BREAKER: On Feb. 10 against Utica, first-year **KEITH LONGO** stopped 29 shots to earn his third shutout of the season. No previous Hobart backstop had ever posted more than two shutouts in a career, let alone a single season.

RECORD BREAKER, II: Speaking of **KEITH LONGO**, the native of Hopedale, Mass., established a new Hobart record for the longest scoreless streak, blanking the opposition for 180 minutes and 24 seconds. His record-breaking streak began in second period of the

Nov. 5 contest at Manhattanville, included back-to-back shutouts of Wentworth and Williams, and ended in the second period against the Milwaukee School of Engineering.

AMONG THE BEST: Three Statesmen are ranked in the top-15 in the nation in four categories. First-year **KEITH LONGO** is fifth in save percentage (.928) and ninth in GAA (2.11). Junior **CONOR BRADLEY** is tied for seventh in power-play goals (11), while senior **GREG GALLAGHER** is 13th in points by a defenseman (5-17-22).

POWERING UP: In a 6-0 victory over Williams, junior forward **CONOR BRADLEY** scored a Hobart single-game record three power-play goals. With 11 on the year, Hobart's leading scorer is just one power-play goal shy of the single-season mark, set by **KEITH LEVINTHAL '94** in 1992-93.

SHORT HANDED? CALL COLBY: While short-handed goals are a relatively rare occurrence, senior **COLBY McVEY** has done quite well when the Statesmen are short a man. Over the past four seasons, McVey has scored six short-handed goals, including two this season. He is one shy of the career record set by **KEITH LEVINTHAL '94**.

GOOD KNIGHT: Senior **ED POIRIER** earned a share of the Hobart single game assists record against the Neumann Knights on Dec. 2, 2005. His four helpers tied the performances by **GREG REYNHOLDS '00** (at Brockport, Oct. 27, 2000), **ANDY BOSCHETTO '02** (vs. Neumann, Nov. 8, 2002), and senior forward **LEE CARRIER** (at Elmira, Nov. 15, 2003).

RED LIGHT DISTRICT: The Statesmen cashed in on four power-play opportunities to tie Hobart's single-game record against Brockport on Jan. 10. Senior forward **WILL BRAME** led the charge with two man-up goals as Hobart stormed back from a three-goal deficit to win 5-3.

LEAGUE LEADERS: Three Statesmen lead the ECAC West in four different categories. Senior forward **COLBY McVEY** has two short-handed goals this season, while junior forward **CONOR BRADLEY** leads the league with 11 power-play goals. First-year **KEITH LONGO** sits atop the conference with a .928 save percentage and a 2.11 GAA.

SPREADING THE WEALTH: Hobart's balanced offense efforts this season have resulted in four players surpassing the 20-point mark. Senior forward **ED POIRIER** and junior forward **CONOR BRADLEY** lead the team with 27 points, while junior forward **MIKE McCARTHY** is three off the pace. Senior defenseman **GREG GALLAGHER** has chipped in 22 points from the blue line.

FROM THE POINT: Senior **GREG GALLAGHER** and first-year **ANDREW BRENNAN** are ranked second and eighth, respectively, in scoring by a defenseman in the ECAC West. Gallagher has scored five goals and assisted on 17 others, while Brennan has three goals and 10 assists.

FOR THE RECORD: Hobart's nine seniors will graduate as the most successful class in terms of wins and winning percentage in the program's 28 varsity seasons. The Class of 2006 has led the Statesmen to a 62-31-11 (.649) record, including two trips to the NCAA Tournament and the 2004 ECAC West Championship.

LISTEN UP: Hobart's NCAA Tournament run will air live on WEOS-FM (89.7/90.3 in Geneva, 88.1 in Ithaca). Veteran radio man **DAN BRONSON** will describe the play-by-play. WEOS also can be heard online at www.weos.org.

SCOUTING THE CADETS: Ranked third in the latest edition of the USCHO.com poll, Norwich (24-4-2) captured the ECAC East Championship with a 5-2 victory over New England College. Offensively, the Cadets have three players with 40 or more points this season, led by senior forward Garett Winder's 46 (19-27). In goal, first-year Chance Gieni has played the majority of Norwich's minutes this season, sporting a 1.95 goals against average and a .914 save percentage.


