TODAY'S GAME—The Statesmen and the Raiders will meet for the 58th time this evening with Hobart holding a 47-8-2 series lead. Hobart has won each of the past 22 meetings, including last season's 10-8 win in Hamilton. The last time Colgate notched a victory over the Statesmen was during the 1964 season (16-9).

STORIED TRADITION—Now in its 102nd season, the Hobart lacrosse program has played 1,089 games and boasts a 682-387-20 (.635) all-time record. Only Johns Hopkins and Syracuse universities can claim more wins. Two hundred and forty-five Statesmen have earned All-American honors, while leading Hobart to 24 NCAA Tournament berths, 13 Division III Championships, two Division II Championships, and a USILA Championship.

PATRIOTS & STATESMEN—Hobart has enjoyed a great deal of success over the past four seasons in the Patriot League. The Statesmen are 23-6 against conference opponents, capturing the league crown in 2000 and again in 2002.

SWAN SONG—Hobart is playing its final season in the Patriot League in 2004. The Statesmen will move to the high-powered ECAC Lacrosse League in 2005. Hobart will join Georgetown, Loyola, Penn State, Rutgers, St. John's, and UMass to form the toughest conference in collegiate lacrosse.

AT THE HELM—The Statesmen are led by third-year Head Coach **MATT KERWICK '90**. The 2002 Patriot League Coach of the Year guided his alma mater to the NCAA Tournament that year and has a 15-20 record at Hobart. Including previous head coaching stops at Alfred University and Randolph-Macon College, Kerwick boasts a 67-51 (.568) career record over eight-plus seasons. No stranger to acclaim, he was named the 1997 Babe Kraus Division III Coach of the Year after leading Alfred to the NCAA Tournament and a 10-4 record. A member of four national championship teams as a student-athlete, Kerwick was a two-time All-American and the MVP of the 1989 NCAA Tournament. He was also a four-year letterwinner in ice hockey.

HELPING HANDS—Assisting Coach Kerwick this season are three of the best coaches in the business. **BRIAN RODGERS** returns for his third season on the sidelines. An All-Ivy League defenseman at Cornell, he followed Kerwick from Georgetown. Second-year assistant **TERRY MUFFLEY** joined the lacrosse staff with more than 20 years of coaching experience at Geneva High School, including three Section V Championships. The newcomer to the group, **RON CHASE** comes to Hobart with four-years of collegiate coaching experience and an outstanding playing career at West Chester University.

POWERFUL STUFF—Nearly half of Hobart's schedule can be found in the Geico/STX USILA Coaches Poll. The Statesmen have lost to Navy (then #9/now #4), Georgetown (#6/#7), and Syracuse (#3/#3) while defeating Bucknell (ORV/NR). Excluding a potential Patriot League Tournament appearance, Hobart still has to face No. 8 Ohio State, No. 9 Army, and No. 16 Cornell.

IRRESISTABLE FORCE MEETS IMMOVABLE OBJECT—Hobart enters tonight's game with the No. 12 scoring offense in Division I, averaging 10.88 goals per game, while Colgate brings the No. 18 scoring defense in Division I, allowing just 7.89 goals per game.

OH CAPTAINS, MY CAPTAINS—Senior midfielder **BRIAN JOY**, junior midfielder **CHRIS SCANLON**, and junior defenseman **GREG McCARTHY** will serve as Hobart's captains this season.

WHERE THERE'S A WILL—Senior attackman **MARK WILLIAMSON** is on pace to score 55 points this season, the most by a Statesmen since **CABEL MADDUX '94** scored 71 points (29-42) in 1993. In case you're wondering, the Hobart single season points record is an astronomical 122 (47-75) set by **RICK GILBERT '74** in 1972.

STREAKING—A transfer from Drexel, **WILLIAMSON** has scored at least two points in every game this season. He has tallied a season-high six points twice this season, burning both Lehigh and Lafayette for five goals and an assist.

THERE'S A WAY TO GOAL—Speaking of Williamson's scoring prowess, he ranks among the nation's best in both points and goals per game. The native of Corning, N.Y., is fifth in points per game (4.25) and ninth in goals per game (2.88).

TOP OF THE HILL—Junior attackman **NATE HILL** enters today's game with 81 career points (34-47). He's on pace to become just the fifth Statesman to record 100 points at the Division I level following **JAMIE BRESLIN '01** (92-46-138), **JOHN BOGOSIAN '03** (88-46-134), **JARED BEBEE '00** (87-40-127), and **NATHAN ROOST '98** (83-27-110).

IT'S A SPECIAL DAY—April 3 is **NATE HILL** Day. This past Saturday saw the attackman score two goals and set up five others to lead Hobart over Bucknell 13-9. The performance matched his career-highs in assists and points, which coincidentally came exactly two years to the day earlier in a 14-10 win over Colgate on McCooey Field.

DAPPER DAN—Junior goalie **DAN VALENTE** has been outstanding between the pipes this season. He ranks fourth in the League in goals against average (8.89) and save percentage (.589).

ALL ABOUT THE TEAM—Hobart is ranked among the top-20 in the nation in three of the categories the NCAA tracks. The Statesmen's man-down defense is the 11th best in the nation with an .849 kill percentage; the scoring offense is 12th (10.88 gpg), while Hobart's +2.00 scoring margin ranks 13th.

US VS. LEAGUE—Hobart ranks among the top-four in the Patriot League in eight different categories. The Statesmen lead the League in penalty killing (.822) and shots (41.12/g), are second in man-up goals (1.38/g), third in goals (10.88/g), ground balls (39.12/g), and man-up scoring (.316), and fourth in points (16.00/g), and save percentage (.587).

SOLID SODEN—Rookie **JOHN SODEN** has had a solid year at the faceoff X for the Statesmen. Sporting a .512 faceoff percentage, Soden ranks ninth in the Patriot League overall and has taken the second most faceoffs in the league (164).

SEEING DOUBLE—The Conklins, attackman **MIKE** and his twin brother **MARK**, a midfielder, are in the starting lineup together tonight for the first time in their collegiate careers. They helped lead West Genesee High School to the 2002 New York State Class A Championship. Standouts in the classroom as well, both brothers were members of the National Honor Society.

SCOUTING THE RAIDERS—Colgate enters tonight's game sporting a 5-4 record (1-1 PL). The Raiders have won each of the past three games, defeating Binghamton 8-7, Sacred Heart 10-7, and Lafayette 11-2. Jeff Vander Meulen leads the team in scoring with 21 goals and four assists. In goal, Andrew Jarolimek boasts a 7.77 goals against average and a .576 save percentage.

LAST SEASON—After Hobart scored six of the game's first seven goals, Colgate managed to battle back and tie the contest, 8-8, with 4:17 remaining. But eight seconds later **TIM BOOTH '03** put the Statesmen back in front and, 30 seconds after that, **CHRIS SCANLON** added an insurance goal as Hobart posted a 10-8 win in Hamilton. Booth led all scorers with three goals and an assist, while winning 14-of-22 at the X and collecting a game-high five ground balls. **MIKE BORSZ '03** made 17 saves to earn the win, while Andrew Jarolimek made nine stops in the loss.
