GAME 7 • RUTGERS (1-3, 0-1) at HOBART (3-3, 0-1)

SERIES SNAPSHOT: The Statesmen and the Scarlet Knights are squaring off for the fourth time this afternoon. Hobart holds a 2-1 series lead, winning the first two showdowns by a combined score of 33-22. However, Rutgers picked up the win last season, claiming an 8-7 overtime triumph in New Jersey.

WHEN LAST WE MET: On March 25, 2006, in Piscataway, Devon Britt scored with 18 seconds remaining in the first overtime session to lift the Scarlet Knights to an 8-7 win over the Statesmen. Daryl Veltman recorded a hat trick for Hobart, while added a pair of goals. Rutgers was led by the three-goal performance of Mike Dugan and the three assists of Chris Doctor.

POTOMAC TWO-STEP: For the fourth consecutive season, Georgetown slipped past Hobart by a two-goal margin, defeating the Statesmen 15-13. **JAMIE KIRK** recorded a game-high six points, all on assists, while **NICK CURRIE** netted a career-high five goals for Hobart. Moved to the nation's capital due to a late season storm, the Statesmen faced a two-goal hole to start the fourth quarter, but back-to-back strikes by **CHRIS DAVID** and Currie tied the game for the eighth and final time. The seventh-ranked Hoyas responded with their own two-goal burst to retake the lead for good.

EXTRA! EXTRA!: The Statesmen began the week fourth in the nation in extraman scoring. They've scored on 55.9 percent (8-15) of their extra-man opportunities this season, including an impressive 5-of-7 showing against Binghamton. It's the most extra-man goals scored by Hobart since netting five at Ohio State on March 12, 2005.

GOAL TIME: In the fastest game on two feet, Hobart is running at the head of the pack in scoring. The Statesmen's 12.17 goals per game is seventh in Division I through games of March 18. Hobart is on pace to score 170 goals this season, the most in a campaign since the program moved to Division I in 1995.

CLEAR DIFFERENCE: In Hobart's three wins this season, the Statesmen are clearing 86.8 percent of the time, while the opposition is successful just 62.2 percent of the time. On the flip side, Hobart's clearing rate slips to 85.2 percent while the opposition improves to 90.3 percent.

CANADIAN CONNECTION: Canadian imports **JAMIE KIRK** and **DARYL VELTMAN** have teamed up to score 14 goals this season (13 Veltman from Kirk and 1 Kirk from Veltman). The former high school teammates at the Salisbury School also play together for the Orangeville Northmen in the Ontario Junior A Summer Lacrosse League.

FEEDER PROGRAM: Junior attackman **JAMIE KIRK** leads the ECAC and is second in the nation with 23 assists. He boasts 52 percent of the team's assists this season. Kirk posted a season-high seven assists against Bucknell.

RECORD WATCH: Speaking of Kirk, he needs just four assists to break Hobart's Division I record for assists in a season. Kirk has dished out 23 helpers in six games (3.83/gm). The current mark was established by **NATE HILL '05**, who set up 26 goals during the 2004 season.

HOT HAND: Junior attackman **DARYL VELTMAN** leads the ECAC and is third in the nation in goals. He's scored 20 through the first six games, averaging 3.33 per contest. Veltman netted a season-high six against Bucknell last month.

ON THE LIST: Speaking of Veltman, he was named to the Tewaaraton Award preseason watch list. Veltman is the second Statesman to be named to the preseason watch list. Two-time All-American defenseman **GREG McCARTHY '05** was the first in 2005.

STREAKY: Four Statesmen enter today's game with consecutive game points streaks. **DARYL VELTMAN** and **NICK CURRIE** have logged at least one point in 11 consecutive games, while **JEFF COLBURN** has notched a point in 10 straight. **JAMIE KIRK** is the fourth, registering a point in seven straight contests, dating back to his final game as a Catamount.

MOVIN' ON UP: DARYL VELTMAN is quickly climbing Hobart's career scoring charts. Among Division I Statesmen, he is sixth in career points (106), four behind No. 5 **NATHAN ROOST '98**; sixth in career goals (70), four shy of No. 5 **MIKE CONKLIN '06**; and sixth in career assists (36), four behind No. 5 **JARED BEBEE '00**.

LUCK NUMBER SEVEN: Senior midfielder **CHRIS DAVID** scored three goals in the win over Marist. It's the seventh time in his career that he's netted three or more goals. David enters today's game ninth in career goals (56) among Division I Statesmen. He's one away from No. 8 **ERIC CURRY '96**.

POINTED ATTACK: Hobart's starting attackmen, Jeff Colburn, Jamie Kirk, and Daryl Veltman, all began the week ranked in the top six in the ECAC in points. Kirk (4.5 ppg) is third, Veltman (4.17) is fourth, and Colburn (3.33) is sixth.

X-CEPTIONAL: Junior **DAN SPINELLA** is second in the ECAC and 15th in the nation in faceoff winning percentage (.578). He is helping himself, averaging 3.3 ground balls per game, well ahead of his 1.67 career average entering this season. Spinella's 61.8 faceoff success rate last season is the best by a Statesmen since the program moved to Division I. The last time a Hobart player was that successful at the X was 1989 when **JACQUES MONTE** '90 won 67.4 percent (196 of 291).

COLLECTION AGENTS: Hobart has collected a league-high 250 ground balls this season thanks in no small part to **MATT SMALLEY** and **MATT RANAGHAN**. Smalley leads the team with 37, while Ranaghan is second with 36. They rank eighth and ninth, respectively, in the nation in ground balls per game.

BAER'S DEN: Senior goalie **BRANDON BAER** has been tough to beat at home. In three games in Geneva, he has a 3.66 goals against average and a .700 save percentage.

THE MOST: Hobart scored the first five goals of the game at Hartford. The last time the Statesmen scored that many unanswered goals was the 2006 22-6 win at Canisius. Hobart produced two five-goal outbursts against the Golden Griffins.

SINGLE DIGITS: When the Hobart defense holds the opposition to nine goals or less, the Statesmen are 29-8 (.784) under Head Coach **MATT KERWICK**.

DOUBLE DUTY: Two Statesmen play more than one sport at Hobart. Junior midfielder **DAN SPINELLA** and sophomore defenseman **JUSTIN HAGER** helped the football team to the NCAA Tournament as a fullback (3.5 yds/att) and linebacker (40 tkls, INT), respectively.

FASTEST TO THE MARK: With his first goal of the game against Marist, **DARYL VELTMAN** became the fastest Hobart player to record 100 career points since the program moved to Division I in 1995. He scored 103 points in his first 32 games as a Statesmen. **NATHAN ROOST '98** was the previous standard, recording his 100th point in his 33rd game.

WELCOME TO THE CLUB: The Statesmen's 12-7 win over St. John's on April 22, 2006, was the 700th victory in the storied history of Hobart lacrosse. In 105 varsity seasons, the Statesmen have an all-time record of 703-408-20 (.630). Hobart is just the third collegiate lacrosse program to reach 700 wins, joining Johns Hopkins and Syracuse universities.

COACH K: Head Coach **MATT KERWICK** is in his sixth season at the helm of his alma mater's lacrosse program. The 2002 Patriot League Coach of the Year has a 36-41 record at Hobart and is 88-72 in 11 seasons as a head coach, including three-year stints at Alfred University and Randolph-Macon College. Last summer, Kerwick served as an assistant coach for the U.S. Lacrosse team that earned a silver medal at the ILF World Championship.

CHAMPIONSHIP TRADITION: Hobart has made 25 appearances in the NCAA Tournament (4 Division I, 6 Division II, 15 Division III) and has won 16 national championships (1 USILA, 2 NCAA DII, 13 NCAA DIII). Hobart is one of only two schools to compete in the NCAA Tournament in all three divisions (Cortland State is the other).

ON THE AIR: All of Hobart's lacrosse games are broadcast by WEOS-FM (89.7/90.3 in Geneva, 88.1 in Ithaca). Outside of WEOS's broadcast area, fans can tune into the station's streaming audio online at www.weos.org. Veteran radio man **TED BAKER** will describe the play-by-play, while **MIKE BLACK** will provide the color commentary.

HOBART'S ONLINE HOME: The official online home of Hobart and William Smith Athletics is located at **www.hws.edu/athletics**. Fans can access schedules, box scores, statistics, rosters and more.

TIME OFF: Rutgers is playing for the first time in 11 days. The Scarlet Knights lost 15-8 on March 13 to then ninth-ranked Princeton. Rutgers was scheduled to play Army on March 16, but the same storm that forced Hobart and Georgetown to head to D.C., forced the postponement of that game.

SCOUTING THE SCARLET KNIGHTS: Rutgers is 1-3 overall, 0-1 in the ECAC. The Scarlet Knights beat Division II Dowling to open the season, but have dropped three straight since. More than 25 percent of RU's goals this season have come in extra-man situations (11 of 40). Colin Checcio leads the team in points with nine goals and two assists. Chris White is the team's top playmaker with four assists. Justin Pennington is the Knights' top faceoff man and leads the team with 16 ground balls. In goal, Lyle Farrar (9.95 GAA, .561 SV%, 1-2) and Peter Pantages (13.45, .474, 0-1) have split time in the cage.

#25 Hobart vs #3 Syracuse (Feb 18, 2007 at Syracuse, N.Y.)

Four unanswered goals late in the fourth quarter saved the third-ranked Syracuse lacrosse team from a second straight loss to Hobart. The Orange rallied from an 11-9 hole to post a 13-11 victory in front of 5,252 fans at the Carrier Dome, reclaiming the Kraus-Simmons Trophy.

DARYL VELTMAN and **JEFF COLBURN** led the Statesmen with two goals and two assists each. Attackman Dan Hardy paced the Orange with three goals and two assists.

NICK CURRIE gave Hobart the early lead, scoring on the game's first shot just 30 seconds in with a laser from the right side of goalie Peter Coluccini (13 saves).

Senior Brandon Baer stopped the first two shots he faced, before Syracuse countered with back-to-back goals. Baer turned in a spectacular first start in the cage, recording 15 saves, including several from point-blank.

It was back and forth affair that saw the lead change hands five times. Colburn's second score with 13:17 remaining put Hobart on top 11-9, but it proved to be the final score of the contest for the Statesmen.

Hobart held an 11-9 advantage on faceoffs entering the fourth quarter, but Syracuse turned things around in the final frame, winning five of six at the X. **DAN SPINELLA** won 12 of 26 restarts.

The Statesmen had a 38-37 advantage on ground balls, led by **MATT SMALLEY** and **MATTHEW RANAGHAN** with seven apiece.

Hobart vs Bucknell (Feb 24, 2007 at Brooklandville, Md.)

Tim Brandau scored with 1:16 remaining in overtime to lift Bucknell to an 11-10 victory over Hobart. Brandau led the Bison with two goals and two assists.

The loss overshadowed several exceptional individual performances. **JAMIE KIRK** recorded a game-high eight points, the most since **DARYL VELTMAN** produced eight points at Canisius last season. Kirk dished out seven assists, including four feeds to Veltman, who finished with six goals, the most by a Hobart player since Feb. 23, 2003, when **JOHN BOGOSIAN '03** netted six against Butler. Bogosian was also the last Hobart player to hand out seven helpers (March 24, 2001, vs. Lehigh).

DAN SPINELLA dominated the faceoff X, winning 17 of the game's 25 restarts, including all 10 in the second quarter, while **MATT SMALLEY** collected a game-high 11 ground balls, many of them on faceoffs, leading the Statesmen to a 44-29 advantage in that category. Smalley's total is the most by a Hobart player since **TIM BOOTH '03** recorded 11 against Lehigh on March 22, 2003.

Bucknell carried a 9-8 lead into the fourth quarter, but with 12:02 remaining in regulation, the final Kirk to Veltman feed tied the game. Hobart claimed its final lead of the day with 86 seconds remaining when Veltman finished a feed from **NICK CURRIE**.

The Bison won the ensuing faceoff and evened the match 39 seconds later on Perry Menzies' third goal of the day to set up Brandau's heroics.
