GAME 8 • #17 FAIRFIELD (5-1, 1-1) at HOBART (3-4, 0-2)

SERIES SNAPSHOT: The Statesmen and the Stags are squaring off for the third time this afternoon. Fairfield won the two previous meetings, 11-8 in 2005 and 15-9 last season.

WHEN LAST WE MET: On April 1, 2006, in Fairfield, Mike Bocklett registered seven points to lift the Stags over the Statesmen 15-9. Fairfield broke open a 1-1 game with five unanswered goals spanning the first and second quarters. The Statesmen won nearly every statistical category, except the final score. Hobart outshot Fairfield 49-32, held a 48-33 advantage on ground balls, and was nearly perfect on clears (84%), while riding the Staggs (65% on clears). **DAN SPINELLA** (8-of-10) and **JOHN SODEN** (10-of-16) dominated the X.

WOE-VERTIME: Hobart suffered its second overtime loss of the season, when Rutgers overcame a two-goal, fourth quarter deficit to steal a 12-11 ECAC win. Daryl Veltman and Chris David both recorded hat tricks, but its wasn't enough to help the Statesmen avoid the double OT setback. Despite the program's distinguished record of success, Hobart is a surprising 9-23 all-time in overtime.

DEJA VU: On Feb. 18, Hobart suffered a two-goal loss to a top-10 team (#3 Syracuse). One month to the day later, the Statesmen fell by two goals to another top-10 team (#7 Georgetown).

DEJA VU ALL OVER AGAIN: On Feb. 24, Hobart suffered a heartbreaking overtime loss to Bucknell. One month to the day later, the Statesmen fell in double overtime to Rutgers. Could a three overtime contest be in store for the April 24 showdown with Canisius?

EXTRA! EXTRA!: The Statesmen began the week third in the nation in extraman scoring. They've converted on 56.3 percent (9-16) of their extra-man opportunities this season, including an impressive 5-of-7 showing against Binghamton, the most man-up goals scored by Hobart since March 12, 2005 (5 vs. Ohio St.).

GOAL TIME: In the fastest game on two feet, Hobart is running at the head of the pack in scoring. The Statesmen's 11.80 goals per game is fifth in Division I through games of March 25. Hobart is on pace to score 165 goals this season, the most in a campaign since the program moved to Division I in 1995.

CLEAR DIFFERENCE: In Hobart's three wins this season, the Statesmen are clearing 86.8 percent of the time, while the opposition is successful just 62.2 percent of the time. On the flip side, Hobart's clearing rate slips to 82.0 percent while the opposition improves to 87.1 percent.

CANADIAN CONNECTION: Canadian imports **JAMIE KIRK** and **DARYL VELTMAN** have teamed up to score 16 goals this season (14 Veltman from Kirk and 2 Kirk from Veltman). The former high school teammates at the Salisbury School also play together for the Orangeville Northmen in the Ontario Junior A Summer Lacrosse League.

FEEDER PROGRAM: Junior attackman **JAMIE KIRK** leads the nation with 24 assists. He boasts 52 percent of the team's helpers this season. Kirk posted a

RECORD WATCH: Speaking of **KIRK**, he needs just three assists to break Hobart's Division I record for assists in a season. Kirk has dished out 24 helpers in seven games (3.43/gm). The current mark was established by **NATE HILL '05**, who set up 26 goals during the 2004 season.

HOT HAND: Junior attackman **DARYL VELTMAN** leads the ECAC and is third in the nation in goals. He's scored 23 at the midway point of the season, averaging 3.29 per contest.

ON THE LIST: Speaking of Veltman, he was named to the Tewaaraton Award preseason watch list. Veltman is the second Statesman to be named to the preseason watch list. Two-time All-American defenseman **GREG McCARTHY '05** was the first in 2005.

STREAKY: Three Statesmen enter today's game with significant consecutive game points streaks. **DARYL VELTMAN** and **NICK CURRIE** have logged at least one point in 12 consecutive games, while **JAMIE KIRK** has registered a point in eight straight contests, dating back to his final game as a Catamount.

MOVIN' ON UP: DARYL VELTMAN is quickly climbing Hobart's career scoring charts. Among Division I Statesmen, he's tied for fifth in career points (110), 17 behind No. 4 **JARED BEBEE '00**; sixth in career goals (73), one shy of No. 5 **MIKE CONKLIN '06**; and sixth in career assists (36), three behind No. 5 **JARED BEBEE '00**.

EIGHT IS GREAT: Senior midfielder **CHRIS DAVID** scored three goals against Rutgers. It's the eighth time in his career that he's netted three or more goals. David enters today's game ninth in career goals (56) among Division I Statesmen. He's one away from No. 8 **ERIC CURRY '96**.

COLLECTION AGENTS: Hobart has collected a league-high 287 ground balls this season thanks in no small part to **MATT SMALLEY** and **MATT RANAGHAN**. Smalley leads the team with 45, while Ranaghan is second with 41. They rank seventh and 10th, respectively, in the nation in ground balls per game.

BAER'S DEN: Senior goalie **BRANDON BAER** has been tough to beat at home. In four games in Geneva, he has a 6.64 goals against average and a .561 save percentage.

SINGLE DIGITS: When the Hobart defense holds the opposition to nine goals or less, the Statesmen are 29-8 (.784) under Head Coach **MATT KERWICK**.

FASTEST TO THE MARK: With his first goal of the game against Marist, **DARYL VELTMAN** became the fastest Hobart player to record 100 career points since the program moved to Division I in 1995. He scored 103 points in his first 32

games as a Statesmen. **NATHAN ROOST '98** was the previous standard, recording his 100th point in his 33rd game.

WELCOME TO THE CLUB: Hobart is one of only three collegiate lacrosse programs to reach the 700-win plateau. (Johns Hopkins and Syracuse are the other two.) The Statesmen have an all-time record of 703-409-20 (.630).

COACH K: Head Coach **MATT KERWICK** is in his sixth season at the helm of his alma mater's lacrosse program. The 2002 Patriot League Coach of the Year has a 36-42 record at Hobart and is 88-73 in 11 seasons as a head coach, including three-year stints at Alfred University and Randolph-Macon College. Last summer, Kerwick served as an assistant coach for the U.S. Lacrosse team that earned a silver medal at the ILF World Championship.

CHAMPIONSHIP TRADITION: Hobart has made 25 appearances in the NCAA Tournament (4 Division I, 6 Division II, 15 Division III) and has won 16 national championships (1 USILA, 2 NCAA DII, 13 NCAA DIII). Hobart is one of only two schools to compete in the NCAA Tournament in all three divisions (Cortland State is the other).

ON THE AIR: All of Hobart's lacrosse games are broadcast by WEOS-FM (89.7/90.3 in Geneva, 88.1 in Ithaca). Outside of WEOS's broadcast area, fans can tune into the station's streaming audio online at www.weos.org. Veteran radio man **TED BAKER** will describe the play-by-play, while **MIKE BLACK** will provide the color commentary.

SCOUTING THE STAGS: Fairfield brings a 5-1 record to Geneva. The Stags are ranked 17th in the coaches poll, 19th in the media poll. Fairfield is eighth in the nation in scoring offense (11.5 gpg). With 17 goals and 10 assists, Senior attackman Mike Bocklet is third in the nation in points (4.5/g), fourth in goals (2.83), and 20th in assists (1.67). Junior attackman Travis Nelson is second on the team in points (12-13-25), ranking fifth in the nation (4.17 ppg) and sixth in assists (2.17). Sophomore midfielder Chris Ajemian leads the team in ground balls with 23. Senior Michael Kruger has started all six games in goal for a defense allowing just 8.5 goals per game.

#25 Hobart vs #3 Syracuse (Feb 18, 2007 at Syracuse, N.Y.)

Four unanswered goals late in the fourth quarter saved the third-ranked Syracuse lacrosse team from a second straight loss to Hobart. The Orange rallied from an 11-9 hole to post a 13-11 victory in front of 5,252 fans at the Carrier Dome, reclaiming the Kraus-Simmons Trophy.

DARYL VELTMAN and **JEFF COLBURN** led the Statesmen with two goals and two assists each. Attackman Dan Hardy paced the Orange with three goals and two assists.

NICK CURRIE gave Hobart the early lead, scoring on the game's first shot just 30 seconds in with a laser from the right side of goalie Peter Coluccini (13 saves).

Senior Brandon Baer stopped the first two shots he faced, before Syracuse countered with back-to-back goals. Baer turned in a spectacular first start in the cage, recording 15 saves, including several from point-blank.

It was back and forth affair that saw the lead change hands five times. Colburn's second score with 13:17 remaining put Hobart on top 11-9, but it proved to be the final score of the contest for the Statesmen.

Hobart held an 11-9 advantage on faceoffs entering the fourth quarter, but Syracuse turned things around in the final frame, winning five of six at the X. **DAN SPINELLA** won 12 of 26 restarts.

The Statesmen had a 38-37 advantage on ground balls, led by **MATT SMALLEY** and **MATTHEW RANAGHAN** with seven apiece.

Hobart vs Bucknell (Feb 24, 2007 at Brooklandville, Md.)

Tim Brandau scored with 1:16 remaining in overtime to lift Bucknell to an 11-10 victory over Hobart. Brandau led the Bison with two goals and two assists.

The loss overshadowed several exceptional individual performances. **JAMIE KIRK** recorded a game-high eight points, the most since **DARYL VELTMAN** produced eight points at Canisius last season. Kirk dished out seven assists, including four feeds to Veltman, who finished with six goals, the most by a Hobart player since Feb. 23, 2003, when **JOHN BOGOSIAN '03** netted six against Butler. Bogosian was also the last Hobart player to hand out seven helpers (March 24, 2001, vs. Lehigh).

DAN SPINELLA dominated the faceoff X, winning 17 of the game's 25 restarts, including all 10 in the second quarter, while **MATT SMALLEY** collected a game-high 11 ground balls, many of them on faceoffs, leading the Statesmen to a 44-29 advantage in that category. Smalley's total is the most by a Hobart player since **TIM BOOTH '03** recorded 11 against Lehigh on March 22, 2003.

Bucknell carried a 9-8 lead into the fourth quarter, but with 12:02 remaining in regulation, the final Kirk to Veltman feed tied the game. Hobart claimed its final lead of the day with 86 seconds remaining when Veltman finished a feed from **NICK CURRIE**.

The Bison won the ensuing faceoff and evened the match 39 seconds later on Perry Menzies' third goal of the day to set up Brandau's heroics.
