SERIES SNAPSHOT: The Statesmen and the Nittany Lions will meet for the 57th time this afternoon, with Hobart holding a 34-21-1 series lead. The teams first met in 1914 with the Statesmen securing a 10-3 win. Hobart also boasts the longest winning streak in the series, claiming 11 in a row between 1969 and 1988. Penn State has the momentum of late however, posting victories in five of the past six meetings.

WHEN LAST WE MET: On April 8, 2006, in Geneva, Drew Adams recorded 17 saves in a 9-4 Penn State win on Boswell Field. The Statesmen won nearly every statistical category, except the one that matters most. Hobart outshot PSU 35-28, had more ground balls (34-23), and did a better job clearing (94.1% vs. 73.9%), but the Statesmen struggled to solve Adams. Gil Pearsall, John Eremus, and Bubba Scott each registered two goals and an assist for the Lions. **SEAN MURPHY** scored twice for Hobart.

STARK CONTRAST: Hobart and Penn State have decidedly different approaches to lacrosse. The Statesmen feature an exciting, fast-paced offense that has yet to be held under 10 goals, while the Nittany Lions have managed 10 goals in only one game this year (a 10-7 win over Fairfield). Penn State features a suffocating defense that has held its last three opponents to an average of 5.7 goals, while Hobart has yielded an average of 12.3 goals in its last three outings.

STARK CONTRAST II: To illustrate the different offensive approaches, consider Gil Pearsall, Penn State's points leader with 10 goals and three assists for 13 points, would be sixth in points on Hobart's roster, trailing **JAMIE KIRK** and **DARYL VELTMAN** by a more than two-to-one margin.

CARDIAC KIDS: When Hobart and Penn State get together its a good bet the final score will be tight. Forty-six percent of the team's meetings have been decided (if at all) by two goals or less. The Statesmen are 10-8 in one-goal games against the Nittany Lions, including a 2-2 mark in overtime, and 4-3 in contests decided by just two goals. The squads also forged a 4-4 tie way back in 1923.

AT THE OTHER EXTREME: Just five games decided by 10 or more goals, blowouts are much rarer than nail-biters in the Hobart-Penn State series. The Statesmen hold the upper hand in that category as well, sporting a 4-1 record when the margin of victory is 10 or more, including the series' most lopsided decision, a 24-5 win in 1972 en route to Hobart's first national championship.

MAD MAX: First-year **MAX SILBERLICHT** made his first collegiate start against then 17th-ranked Fairfield on March 31 a memorable one. He registered 17 saves, the most by a Statesman this season and the most by a Hobart goalie making his first start since **FRED PAWLIKOWSKI '98** turned away 17 in his first start against Syracuse on April 12, 1995. Silberlicht's efforts earned him the ECAC Rookie of the Week award.

ANOTHER AWARD-WINNING PERFORMANCE: Junior attackman **JAMIE KIRK** earned a pair of weekly awards for his six-point effort against the Stags. He posted a game-high four assists and scored a pair of fourth quarter goals, including what proved to be the game-winner, to earn the ECAC Co-Offensive Player

EXTRA! EXTRA!: The Statesmen began the week third in the nation in extra-man scoring. They've converted on 52.4 percent (11-21) of their extra-man opportunities this season, including an impressive 5-of-7 showing against Binghamton, the most man-up goals scored by Hobart since March 12, 2005 (5 vs. Ohio St.).

GOAL TIME: In the fastest game on two feet, Hobart is running at the head of the pack in scoring. The Statesmen's 11.88 goals per game is fifth in Division I through games of April 1. Hobart is on pace to score 166 goals this season, the most in a campaign since the program moved to Division I in 1995.

CANADIAN CONNECTION: Canadian imports **JAMIE KIRK** and **DARYL VELTMAN** have teamed up to score 19 goals this season (17 Veltman from Kirk and 2 Kirk from Veltman). The former high school teammates at the Salisbury School also play together for the Orangeville Northmen in the Ontario Junior A Summer Lacrosse League.

FEEDER PROGRAM: Junior attackman **JAMIE KIRK** leads the nation with 28 assists. That's as many as the next two players in the conference combined (Georgetown's Brendan Cannon and Fairfield's Travis Nelson both have 14). Kirk boasts 52 percent of the team's helpers this season.

BROKEN RECORD: Speaking of **KIRK**, in Hobart's 11-10 victory over then 17th-ranked Fairfield, he handed out four assists, breaking the season record for a Division I Statesman. The former mark was established by **NATE HILL '05**, who set up 26 goals in 16 games during the 2004 season. The next step for Kirk is to crack the all-time top 20. **LARRY ADKINSON '62**, **ROY McADAM '80**, **BILL MILLER '91**, and **JEFF TAMBRONI '92** are tied for 17th on that list with campaigns of 31 helpers.

BEAM ME UP: How fast is **JAMIE KIRK** climbing Hobart's assist lists? In just eight games, the transfer from Vermont is already tied for 10th among Division I Statesmen in CAREER assists with 28. At his present pace of 3.5 helpers per game, Kirk could become just the sixth Hobart player to record 100 career assists and the first since **CABELL MADDUX '94** (102) joined the club.

HOT HAND: Junior attackman **DARYL VELTMAN** leads the ECAC and is third in the nation in goals. He's scored 26 through eight games, averaging 3.25 per contest. No other player in the ECAC has more than 19 goals this season.

MOVIN' ON UP: **DARYL VELTMAN** is quickly climbing Hobart's career scoring charts. Among Division I Statesmen, he's fifth in career points (113), 14 behind No. 4 **JARED BEBEE '00**; fifth in career goals (76), seven shy of No. 4 **NATHAN ROOST '98**; and sixth in career assists (37), two behind No. 5 **BEBEE**.

ON THE LIST: Speaking of Veltman, he was named to the Tewaaron Award preseason watch list. Veltman is the second Statesman to be named to the pre-season watch list. Two-time All-American defenseman **GREG McCARTHY '05** was the first in 2005.

STREAKY: Three Statesmen enter today's game with significant consecutive game point streaks. **DARYL VELTMAN** and **NICK CURRIE** have logged at least one point in 13 consecutive games, while **JAMIE KIRK** has registered a point in nine straight contests, dating back to his final game as a Catamount.

NINE IS FINE: Senior midfielder **CHRIS DAVID** scored three goals against Fairfield. It's the nine time in his career that he's netted three or more goals. David enters today's game tied with **NATE HILL '05** for seventh in career goals (64) among Division I Statesmen. He's 10 behind No. 6 **MIKE CONKLIN '06**.

COLLECTION AGENTS: Hobart has collected a league-high 320 ground balls this season thanks in no small part to **MATT SMALLEY** and **MATT RANAGHAN**. The pair is tied for the team lead with 47 apiece. They rank third in the ECAC and ninth in the nation in ground balls per game.

CLEAR DIFFERENCE: Hobart's ability to ride Penn State could be a key factor in today's game. In their four wins this season, the Statesmen are riding the opposition 33.3 percent of the time. In four defeats, Hobart has ridden its opponents just 12.9 percent of the time.

DOWN WITH DEFENSE: Another key to success could be Hobart's man-down defense. When the Statesmen win, they've limited the opposition to a 15.8 success rate with the extra-man (3-19), but in defeat, their opponents' extra-man production jumps to 45.5 percent (5-11).

SINGLE DIGITS: When the Hobart defense holds the opposition to nine goals or less, the Statesmen are 29-8 (.784) under Head Coach **MATT KERWICK**.

FASTEST TO THE MARK: With his first goal of the game against Marist, **DARYL VELTMAN** became the fastest Hobart player to record 100 career points

since the program moved to Division I in 1995. He scored 103 points in his first 32 games as a Statesmen. **NATHAN ROOST '98** was the previous standard, recording his 100th point in his 33rd game.

WELCOME TO THE CLUB: Hobart is one of only three collegiate lacrosse programs to reach the 700-win plateau. (Johns Hopkins and Syracuse are the other two.) The Statesmen have an all-time record of 704-409-20 (.630).

COACH K: Head Coach **MATT KERWICK** is in his sixth season at the helm of his alma mater's lacrosse program. The 2002 Patriot League Coach of the Year has a 37-42 record at Hobart and is 89-73 in 11 seasons as a head coach, including three-year stints at Alfred University and Randolph-Macon College. Last summer, Kerwick served as an assistant coach for the U.S. Lacrosse team that earned a silver medal at the ILF World Championship.

CHAMPIONSHIP TRADITION: Hobart has made 25 appearances in the NCAA Tournament (4 Division I, 6 Division II, 15 Division III) and has won 16 national championships (1 USILA, 2 NCAA DII, 13 NCAA DIII). Hobart is one of only two schools to compete in the NCAA Tournament in all three divisions (Cortland State is the other).

ON THE AIR: All of Hobart's lacrosse games are broadcast by WEOS-FM (89.7/90.3 in Geneva, 88.1 in Ithaca). Outside of WEOS's broadcast area, fans can tune into the station's streaming audio online at www.weos.org. Veteran radio man **TED BAKER** will describe the play-by-play, while **MIKE BLACK** will provide the color commentary.

SCOUTING THE NITTANY LIONS: Penn State (2-5, 1-2) is coming off a heart-breaking 6-5 overtime loss at Massachusetts last Saturday. The Nittany Lions are scoring 7.41 goals per game, while allowing 8.27 (21st in the nation). The defense is led by sophomore goalie Drew Adams. He's 13th in the nation in save percentage (.594) and 23rd in GAA (8.31). Junior Devin Madden is the team's primary option at the faceoff X. He's won 42 of the 91 restarts he's taken. Offensively, Gil Pearsall leads the team with 10 goals and 13 points. Brian Boyle is the Lions' top playmaker with five of his 11 points coming on assists.

Four unanswered goals late in the fourth quarter saved the third-ranked Syracuse lacrosse team from a second straight loss to Hobart. The Orange rallied from an 11-9 hole to post a 13-11 victory in front of 5,252 fans at the Carrier Dome, reclaiming the Kraus-Simmons Trophy.

DARYL VELTMAN and **JEFF COLBURN** led the Statesmen with two goals and two assists each. Attackman Dan Hardy paced the Orange with three goals and two assists.

NICK CURRIE gave Hobart the early lead, scoring on the game's first shot just 30 seconds in with a laser from the right side of goalie Peter Coluccini (13 saves).

Senior Brandon Baer stopped the first two shots he faced, before Syracuse countered with back-to-back goals. Baer turned in a spectacular first start in the cage, recording 15 saves, including several from point-blank.

It was back and forth affair that saw the lead change hands five times. Colburn's second score with 13:17 remaining put Hobart on top 11-9, but it proved to be the final score of the contest for the Statesmen.

Hobart held an 11-9 advantage on faceoffs entering the fourth quarter, but Syracuse turned things around in the final frame, winning five of six at the X. **DAN SPINELLA** won 12 of 26 restarts.

The Statesmen had a 38-37 advantage on ground balls, led by **MATT SMALLEY** and **MATTHEW RANAGHAN** with seven apiece.
