Hobart Statesmen LACROSSE GAME 10 • MASSACHUSETTS (4-5, 2-1) at HOBART (4-5, 1-3)

SERIES SNAPSHOT: The Statesmen and the Minutemen will meet for the eighth time this afternoon, with Massachusetts holding a 5-2 series lead. The teams first met in 1972 with the Statesmen securing a 13-2 win in the semifinals of the USILA championship tournament. UMass has won each of the past two meetings.

WHEN LAST WE MET: On April 15, 2006, in Amherst, Mass., the Minutemen scored the game's first five goals en route to a 13-7 win on Garber Field. Facing a 7-2 hole early in the third quarter, Hobart managed to score three of the next four goals to get within three of its host, but UMass netted five of the game's final seven goals to squash the comeback bid. **CHRIS DAVID** scored a pair of goals to lead the Statesmen, while nine different Minutemen found the back of the net, led by the three-point effort of Sean Morris (2-1). Rory Pedrick also had three points (1-2) for UMass.

SENIOR DAY: The Hobart Athletics Department will salute the eight members of the lacrosse team that will graduate next month. **BRANDON BAER**, **CHRIS DAVID**, **JAMES DUSSICH**, **CHRIS KEOUGH**, **WESLEY MCDONALD**, **JUSTIN PORTER**, **MATT RANAGHAN**, and **JOHN SODEN** will be honored for their dedication to excellence prior to the start of today's game.

YOUR BUCK GOES HERE: During the Hobart-UMass game, Hobart studentathletes will be accepting donations to benefit Camp Onseyawa. Funded by the Rotary clubs of Ontario, Seneca, Yates, and Wayne counties, Camp Onseyawa is a two-week summer camp for children with special needs.

35TH ANNIVERSARY: At halftime, Hobart Athletics will honor the 1972 Statesmen lacrosse team that won the College's first national championship. Hobart was 17-1 overall that season, winning eight in a row to close out the year, capped with a 15-12 triumph over Washington in the USILA Championship Game. The 1972 squad will be named a Hobart Team of Distinction, just the fifth team to be so honored, joining the undefeated lacrosse teams of 1938 and 1940 and the undefeated football teams of 1954 and 1957.

MAD MAX: First-year **MAX SILBERLICHT** made his first collegiate start against then 17th-ranked Fairfield on March 31 a memorable one. He registered 17 saves, the most by a Statesman this season and the most by a Hobart goalie making his first start since **FRED PAWLIKOWSKI '98** turned away 17 in his first start against Syracuse on April 12, 1995. Silberlicht's efforts earned him the ECAC Rookie of the Week award.

EXTRA! EXTRA!: The Statesmen began the week third in the nation in extraman scoring. They've converted on 50.0 percent (12-24) of their extra-man opportunities this season, including an impressive 5-of-7 showing against Binghamton, the most man-up goals scored by Hobart since March 12, 2005 (5 vs. Ohio St.).

SOMETHING'S GOTTA GIVE: While Hobart has excelled in man-up situations this season, Massachusetts' man-down defense has been correspondingly stingy. The Minutemen have allowed just five extra-man goals, while killing off 23 tries by the opposition.

GOAL TIME: In the fastest game on two feet, Hobart is running at the head of the pack in scoring. The Statesmen's 11.33 goals per game is sixth in Division I and tops in the ECAC through games of April 8.

CANADIAN CONNECTION: Canadian imports **JAMIE KIRK** and **DARYL VELTMAN** have teamed up to score 19 goals this season (17 Veltman from Kirk and 2 Kirk from Veltman). The former high school teammates at the Salisbury School also play together for the Orangeville Northmen in the Ontario Junior A Summer Lacrosse League.

FEEDER PROGRAM: Junior attackman **JAMIE KIRK** leads the nation with 29 assists. That's nearly twice as many as the next player in the conference (Georgetown's Brendan Cannon has 16). Kirk boasts 52 percent of the team's helpers this season.

BROKEN RECORD: Speaking of **KIRK**, in Hobart's 11-10 victory over then 17th-ranked Fairfield, he handed out four assists, breaking the season record for a Division I Statesman. The former mark was established by **NATE HILL '05**, who set up 26 goals in 16 games during the 2004 season. The next step for Kirk is to crack the all-time top 20. **LARRY ADKINSON '62**, **ROY MCADAM '80**, **BILL MILLER '91**, and **JEFF TAMBRONI '92** are tied for 17th on that list with campaigns of 31 helpers.

BEAM ME UP: How fast is **JAMIE KIRK** climbing Hobart's assist lists? In just nine games, the transfer from Vermont is already 10th among Division I Statesmen in CAREER assists with 29. At his present pace of 3.2 helpers per game, Kirk would crack the all-time top 10 by the end of next season.

HOT HAND: Junior attackman **DARYL VELTMAN** leads the ECAC and is fourth in the nation in goals. He's scored 27 through nine games, averaging 3.0 per contest.

MOVIN' ON UP: DARYL VELTMAN is quickly climbing Hobart's career scoring charts. Among Division I Statesmen, he's fifth in career points (114), 13 behind No. 4 **JARED BEBEE '00**; fifth in career goals (77), six shy of No. 4 **NATHAN ROOST '98**; and sixth in career assists (37), two behind No. 5 **BEBEE**.

NINE IS FINE: Senior midfielder **CHRIS DAVID** scored three goals against Fairfield. It's the nine time in his career that he's netted three or more goals. David enters today's game seventh in career goals (66) among Division I Statesmen. He's eight behind No. 6 **MIKE CONKLIN '06**.

COLLECTION AGENTS: Hobart has collected a league-high 353 ground balls this season thanks in no small part to **MATT SMALLEY** and **MATT RANAGHAN**. Smalley leads the team with 52, while Ranaghan is second with 51. Smalley is third in the conference and sixth in the nation, just ahead of Ranaghan (4th/8th).

CLEAR DIFFERENCE: Hobart's ability to ride Massachusetts could be a key factor in today's game. In their four wins this season, the Statesmen are riding the opposition 33.3 percent of the time. In five defeats, Hobart has ridden its opponents just 11.0 percent of the time.

DOWN WITH DEFENSE: Another key to success could be Hobart's man-down defense. When the Statesmen win, they've limited the opposition to a 15.8 success rate with the extra-man (3-19), but in defeat, their opponents' extra-man production jumps to 37.5 percent (6-16).

SINGLE DIGITS: When the Hobart defense holds the opposition to nine goals or less, the Statesmen are 29-8 (.784) under Head Coach **MATT KERWICK**.

FASTEST TO THE MARK: With his first goal of the game against Marist, **DARYL VELTMAN** became the fastest Hobart player to record 100 career points since the program moved to Division I in 1995. He scored 103 points in his first 32 games as a Statesmen. **NATHAN ROOST '98** was the previous standard, recording his 100th point in his 33rd game.

WELCOME TO THE CLUB: Hobart is one of only three collegiate lacrosse programs to reach the 700-win plateau. (Johns Hopkins and Syracuse are the other two.) The Statesmen have an all-time record of 704-410-20 (.630).

COACH K: Head Coach **MATT KERWICK** is in his sixth season at the helm of his alma mater's lacrosse program. The 2002 Patriot League Coach of the Year has a 37-43 record at Hobart and is 89-74 in 11 seasons as a head coach, including three-year stints at Alfred University and Randolph-Macon College. Last

summer, Kerwick served as an assistant coach for the U.S. Lacrosse team that earned a silver medal at the ILF World Championship.

OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN: Senior defenseman **CHRIS KEOUGH** and junior midfielder **SEAN MURPHY** will serve as co-captains for the 2007 season.

DOUBLE DUTY: Two Statesmen play more than one sport at Hobart. Junior midfielder **DAN SPINELA** and sophomore defenseman **JUSTIN HAGER** helped the football team to the NCAA Tournament as a fullback (3.5 yds/att) and linebacker (40 tkls, INT), respectively.

CHAMPIONSHIP TRADITION: Hobart has made 25 appearances in the NCAA Tournament (4 Division I, 6 Division II, 15 Division III) and has won 16 national championships (1 USILA, 2 NCAA DII, 13 NCAA DIII). Hobart is one of only two schools to compete in the NCAA Tournament in all three divisions (Cortland State is the other).

ON THE AIR: All of Hobart's lacrosse games are broadcast by WEOS-FM (89.7/90.3 in Geneva, 88.1 in Ithaca). Outside of WEOS's broadcast area, fans can tune into the station's streaming audio online at www.weos.org. Veteran radio man **TED BAKER** will describe the play-by-play, while **MIKE BLACK** will provide the color commentary.

HOBART'S ONLINE HOME: The official online home of Hobart and William Smith Athletics is located at **www.hws.edu/athletics**. Fans can access schedules, box scores, statistics, rosters and more.

SCOUTING THE MINUTEMEN: Massachusetts (4-5, 2-1) comes to Geneva riding a two-game win streak. The Minutemen rallied from a 6-3 halftime deficit to take down St. John's 11-7 last Saturday. UMass ranks in the top 20 in the nation in man-down defense (4th, .821), man-up offense (14th, .348), and scoring defense (15th, 7.56). Sophomore goalie Doc Schneider is 13th in the nation in both goals against average (7.58) and save percentage (.595). Senior midfielder Brett Garber and sophomore attackman Jim Connolly lead the team in points column with 22 apiece. Garber has 18 goals and four assists, while Connolly boasts 15 goals and seven assists. Junior midfielder Rory Pedrick is the team's top playmaker with nine helpers. First-year midfielder Bobby Hayes is UMass' top option at the faceoff X. He's won 69 of 137 restarts this season (.504).

ON THE HORIZON: Hobart heads to the Big Apple for an ECAC showdown with St. John's. The Statesmen and Red Storm will square off on DaSilva Field at 1 p.m. on April 21. Hobart has won the two previous meetings with St. John's by a combined score of 25-16.

#25 Hobart vs #3 Syracuse (Feb 18, 2007 at Syracuse, N.Y.)

Four unanswered goals late in the fourth quarter saved the third-ranked Syracuse lacrosse team from a second straight loss to Hobart. The Orange rallied from an 11-9 hole to post a 13-11 victory in front of 5,252 fans at the Carrier Dome, reclaiming the Kraus-Simmons Trophy.

DARYL VELTMAN and **JEFF COLBURN** led the Statesmen with two goals and two assists each. Attackman Dan Hardy paced the Orange with three goals and two assists.

NICK CURRIE gave Hobart the early lead, scoring on the game's first shot just 30 seconds in with a laser from the right side of goalie Peter Coluccini (13 saves).

Senior Brandon Baer stopped the first two shots he faced, before Syracuse countered with back-to-back goals. Baer turned in a spectacular first start in the cage, recording 15 saves, including several from point-blank.

It was back and forth affair that saw the lead change hands five times. Colburn's second score with 13:17 remaining put Hobart on top 11-9, but it proved to be the final score of the contest for the Statesmen.

Hobart held an 11-9 advantage on faceoffs entering the fourth quarter, but Syracuse turned things around in the final frame, winning five of six at the X. **DAN SPINELLA** won 12 of 26 restarts.

The Statesmen had a 38-37 advantage on ground balls, led by **MATT SMALLEY** and **MATTHEW RANAGHAN** with seven apiece.
