SERIES SNAPSHOT: The Statesmen and the Red Storm will meet for the third time this afternoon, with Hobart holding a 2-0 series lead. The teams first met in 2005 with the Statesmen securing a 13-9 win at DaSilva Field. Hobart followed that up with a 12-7 on Boswell Field last season.

WHEN LAST WE MET: April 22, 2006, was a momentous occasion in the tradition-rich history of Hobart lacrosse. On legendary Boswell Field, the Statesmen posted a 12-7 win over the St. John's Red Storm becoming just the third lacrosse program to record 700 all-time wins. Hobart dominated shots (34-22), ground balls (48-28), and faceoffs (19-3). **DAN SPINELLA** was 19-of-20 at the X, while **MATT SMALLEY** collected a game-high nine ground balls. On attack, **DARYL VELTMAN** and **NICK CURRIE** led the way with three goals and an assist apiece. The Statesmen broke open a 9-7 game with three fourth quarter goals in a span of just 86 seconds. Currie netted the first followed by back-to-back tallies by **JEFF COLBURN**. The defense, meanwhile, shutout the Storm over the final 11 minutes to secure the victory.

WHAT'S DEFENSE GOT TO DO WITH IT?: Hobart's 12 goals against Massachusetts last Saturday are the most scored against the Minutemen this season. Unfortunately, UMass did the same to the Statesmen defense, leaving Geneva with an 17-12 win. Eight different Statesmen registered goals. The 29 combined goals are the most in a Hobart game since Penn State and the Statesmen put 32 on the board in 2005.

YOUR BUCK GOES HERE: During the Hobart-UMass game, Hobart student-athletes solicited donations from fans to benefit Camp Onseyawa. Funded by the Rotary clubs of Ontario, Seneca, Yates, and Wayne counties, Camp Onseyawa is a two-week summer camp for children with special needs. Contributions to the annual fund raiser brought in \$1,010.76.

EXTRA! EXTRA!: The Statesmen began the week fourth in the nation in extra-man scoring. They've converted on 50.0 percent (14-28) of their extra-man opportunities this season. Hobart's extra-man unit has not been this productive since the program moved to Division I in 1995. The current DI standard for a season was set by the 1999 squad (.453, 29-64).

SOMETHING'S GOTTA GIVE: While Hobart has excelled in man-up situations this season, St. John's man-down defense has been correspondingly stingy. Ranked eighth in the nation, the Red Storm has allowed just six extra-man goals, while killing off 26 tries by the opposition (.800).

GOAL TIME: In the fastest game on two feet, Hobart is running in the lead pack in scoring. The Statesmen's 11.4 goals per game is eighth in Division I and tops in the ECAC through games of April 16.

CANADIAN CONNECTION: Canadian imports **JAMIE KIRK** and **DARYL VELTMAN** have teamed up to score 21 goals this season (18 Veltman from Kirk and 3 Kirk from Veltman). The former high school teammates at the Salisbury School also play together for the Orangeville Northmen in the Ontario Junior A Summer Lacrosse League.

FEEDER PROGRAM: Junior attackman **JAMIE KIRK** leads the nation with 31 assists. That's nearly twice as many as the next player in the conference (Georgetown's Brendan Cannon has 18). Kirk boasts 49 percent of the team's helpers this season.

BROKEN RECORD: Speaking of **KIRK**, in Hobart's 11-10 victory over then 17th-ranked Fairfield, he handed out four assists, breaking the season record for a Division I Statesman. The former mark was established by **NATE HILL '05**, who set up 26 goals in 16 games during the 2004 season. The next step for Kirk is climbing the all-time top 20. Each of his next five assists will move him up in the rankings.

BEAM ME UP: How fast is **JAMIE KIRK** climbing Hobart's assist lists? In just 10 games, the transfer from Vermont is already seventh among Division I Statesmen in CAREER assists with 31. At his present pace of 3.1 helpers per game, Kirk would crack the all-time top 10 by the end of next season.

HOT HAND: Junior attackman **DARYL VELTMAN** leads the ECAC and is fifth in the nation in goals. He's scored 29 through 10 games and is on pace to break Hobart's Division I record. **NATHAN ROOST '98** set the current season mark with 37 goals in 1997. Veltman's scoring rate projects out to 40.6 goals over 14 games.

MOVIN' ON UP: **DARYL VELTMAN** is quickly climbing Hobart's career scoring charts. Among Division I Statesmen, he's fifth in career points (117), 10 behind No. 4 **JARED BEBEE '00**; fifth in career goals (79), four shy of No. 4 **NATHAN ROOST '98**; and sixth in career assists (38), one behind No. 5 **BEBEE**.

STREAKY: Three Statesmen enter today's game with significant consecutive game point streaks. **DARYL VELTMAN** and **NICK CURRIE** have logged at least one point in 15 consecutive games, while **JAMIE KIRK** has registered a point in 11 straight contests, dating back to his final game as a Catamount.

NINE IS FINE: Senior midfielder **CHRIS DAVID** scored three goals against Fairfield. It's the ninth time in his career that he's netted three or more goals. Da-

vid enters today's game seventh in career goals (68) among Division I Statesmen. He's six behind No. 6 **MIKE CONKLIN '06**.

COLLECTION AGENTS: Hobart has collected a league-high 386 ground balls this season thanks in no small part to **MATT RANAGHAN** and **MATT SMALLEY**. Ranaghan leads the team with 58, while Smalley is second with 57. Ranaghan is third in the conference and eighth in the nation, just ahead of Smalley (4th/9th).

CLEAR DIFFERENCE: Hobart's ability to ride St. John's could be a key factor in today's game. In their four wins this season, the Statesmen are riding the opposition 33.3 percent of the time. In six defeats, Hobart has ridden its opponents just 12.1 percent of the time.

DOWN WITH DEFENSE: Another key to success could be Hobart's man-down defense. When the Statesmen win, they've limited the opposition to a 15.8 success rate with the extra-man (3-19), but in defeat, their opponents' extra-man production jumps to 38.9 percent (7-18). For the season, St. John's is just 6-of-32 with the man advantage (18.8%).

SINGLE DIGITS: When the Hobart defense holds the opposition to nine goals or less, the Statesmen are 29-8 (.784) under Head Coach **MATT KERWICK**.

FASTEST TO THE MARK: With his first goal of the game against Marist, **DARYL VELTMAN** became the fastest Hobart player to record 100 career points since the program moved to Division I in 1995. He scored 103 points in his first 32 games as a Statesmen. **NATHAN ROOST '98** was the previous standard, recording his 100th point in his 33rd game.

WELCOME TO THE CLUB: Hobart is one of only three collegiate lacrosse programs to reach the 700-win plateau. (Johns Hopkins and Syracuse are the other two.) The Statesmen have an all-time record of 704-411-20 (.630).

COACH K: Head Coach **MATT KERWICK** is in his sixth season at the helm of his alma mater's lacrosse program. The 2002 Patriot League Coach of the Year has a 37-44 record at Hobart and is 89-75 in 11 seasons as a head coach, including three-year stints at Alfred University and Randolph-Macon College. Last summer, Kerwick served as an assistant coach for the U.S. Lacrosse team that earned a silver medal at the ILF World Championship.

OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN: Senior defenseman **CHRIS KEOUGH** and junior midfielder **SEAN MURPHY** will serve as co-captains for the 2007 season.

DOUBLE DUTY: Two Statesmen play more than one sport at Hobart. Junior midfielder **DAN SPINELLA** and sophomore defenseman **JUSTIN HAGER** helped the football team to the NCAA Tournament as a fullback (3.5 yds/att) and line-backer (40 tkls, INT), respectively.

CHAMPIONSHIP TRADITION: Hobart has made 25 appearances in the NCAA Tournament (4 Division I, 6 Division II, 15 Division III) and has won 16 national championships (1 USILA, 2 NCAA DII, 13 NCAA DIII). Hobart is one of only two schools to compete in the NCAA Tournament in all three divisions (Cortland State is the other).

ON THE AIR: All of Hobart's lacrosse games are broadcast by WEOS-FM (89.7/90.3 in Geneva, 88.1 in Ithaca). Outside of WEOS's broadcast area, fans can tune into the station's streaming audio online at www.weos.org. Veteran radio man **TED BAKER** will describe the play-by-play, while **MIKE BLACK** will provide the color commentary.

HOBART'S ONLINE HOME: The official online home of Hobart and William Smith Athletics is located at www.hws.edu/athletics. Fans can access schedules, box scores, statistics, rosters and more.

SCOUTING THE RED STORM: St. John's (4-7, 1-4) enters today's game looking to snap a two-game slide following losses to Massachusetts 11-7, and Penn State 9-5. The Red Storm is last in the ECAC in scoring offense (6.82 gpg) and fourth in scoring defense (8.82). SJU leads the league in man-down defense (.800). In goal, Dan Goldberg (2-4) and Dave Saccente (1-3) have split time in goal. Goldberg has stopped 60 percent of the shots he's faced and sports an 8.94 goals against average, while Saccente has an 8.66 GAA and a .527 save percentage. Faceoff specialist Jack Rosson leads the team in ground balls with 50 and has won 48.7 percent at the X. Offensively, Tom Michaelson leads the team in assists and points (16-13-29), while Trevor Michaelson is the top goal scorer (18-3-21).

ON THE HORIZON: Hobart returns home for the final time this season, when the Statesmen host Canisius under the lights of McCooley Field on April 24. Faceoff is scheduled for 7 p.m.

Four unanswered goals late in the fourth quarter saved the third-ranked Syracuse lacrosse team from a second straight loss to Hobart. The Orange rallied from an 11-9 hole to post a 13-11 victory in front of 5,252 fans at the Carrier Dome, reclaiming the Kraus-Simmons Trophy.

DARYL VELTMAN and **JEFF COLBURN** led the Statesmen with two goals and two assists each. Attackman Dan Hardy paced the Orange with three goals and two assists.

NICK CURRIE gave Hobart the early lead, scoring on the game's first shot just 30 seconds in with a laser from the right side of goalie Peter Coluccini (13 saves).

Senior Brandon Baer stopped the first two shots he faced, before Syracuse countered with back-to-back goals. Baer turned in a spectacular first start in the cage, recording 15 saves, including several from point-blank.

It was back and forth affair that saw the lead change hands five times. Colburn's second score with 13:17 remaining put Hobart on top 11-9, but it proved to be the final score of the contest for the Statesmen.

Hobart held an 11-9 advantage on faceoffs entering the fourth quarter, but Syracuse turned things around in the final frame, winning five of six at the X. **DAN SPINELLA** won 12 of 26 restarts.

The Statesmen had a 38-37 advantage on ground balls, led by **MATT SMALLEY** and **MATTHEW RANAGHAN** with seven apiece.
