

## 2007 Colgate Men's Soccer Season in Review

The Raiders are coming off their most successful season in recent years. Colgate won the 2007 Patriot League Championship and advanced to the NCAA Division I Tournament for the first time in 41 years. Colgate fell by just one goal to South Florida, 2-1, despite outshooting the Bulls, who reached the Third Round, 11-9.

Colgate finished the season with a 9-6-5 record and a 4-1-2 mark in the league. The Raiders were in the NSCAA Mid-Atlantic regional rankings all season, and held the No. 2 slot for the final five weeks of the soccer season.

Senior Eric Anton and Dan Belke were named the Patriot League Offensive and Defensive Players of the Year, respectively. Both earned places on the all-league first team, as well as junior Matt Leach. Junior goalkeeper David Cappuccio earned second-team all-league honors. Anton, Belke and Cappuccio were all named to the all-region teams by the NSCAA.



## 2007 Hobart Men's Soccer Season in Review

The Statesmen are coming off of an unprecedented season, in 2007. Hobart ranked as high as fifth in the nation and were 20th in the final coaches poll with a 12-4-3 final record. The team posted a 3-1-3 mark in the Liberty League, falling to St. Lawrence in the conference semifinals.

Hobart's season did not end there, as it earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Division III Tournament for the second straight season. They advanced to the second round of the tournament with a 3-0 win over Fredonia State, before falling to Rochester, 2-0 in the second round.

Eight players were named all-Liberty League including Pete Van Dellon on the first team; Tyler Webster, Dan Riso, Phillip Schoeniger and Matt Schwartz on the second team; and Brad Weinberg, Tom Moulton and Sam Wisner garnering honorable mention nods. Weinberg and Schoeniger were also named all-region by the NSCAA.



ERIK RONNING Camp Director

Erik Ronning is in his third year as the John W. Beyer Head Coach for Men's Soccer at Colgate University.

He has taken the Raiders to the Patriot League Tournament each season since he's been at Colgate. Colgate won the 2007 Patriot League Championship with a shutout

over Lafayette in the title match and earned a berth in the NCAA Division I Men's Soccer Tournament, for the first time in 41 years. The Raiders fell 2-1 to South Florida in the first round, despite outshooting the Bulls, 11-9.

A former Raider, Ronning was a four-year starter and team captain in 1996. He was named first-team all-Patriot League and team MVP his senior year.

After graduation, Ronning worked as Colgate's assistant coach from 1997-2001. Following his stint as an assistant at Colgate, Ronning spent four years at Northwestern University as both an assistant and associate coach of the men's soccer program.



SHAWN GRIFFIN Camp Director

Shawn Griffin is in his eighth season at the helm of the Hobart Statesmen.

This past season, Griffin guided the team to a 12-4-3 record and won its first NCAA Tournament game in program history, after being nationally-ranked all season.

Prior to joining Hobart, Griffin served nine seasons at his alma mater Plymouth State. As head coach, he led the Panthers to the three NCAA Tournaments, coached six All-Americans and seven Little East conference players of the year.

A 1988 graduate of Plymouth State, Griffin played on three NCAA Tournament teams, helping the Panthers amass a 52-14-16 record.

Overall, Griffin has compiled a career record of 165-108-25 (.596) in 16 years as a head coach. He has mentored 35 NSCAA all-region and 79 all-conference selections.

## Soccer Camp Philosophy

The New York Elite ID Camp provides the ideal developmental atmosphere for the serious soccer player with ambitions of playing collegiate soccer. The staff will push players in all aspects of the game, while providing a competitive atmosphere for all participants. The coaches on staff are devoted to the individual improvement of each player through specific skill instruction, tactical training, small sided situations, and 11 vs. 11 game. At the conclusion of camp, you will know what it takes to compete at the collegiate level.

# Instruction will be given in the following areas:

- Technical concepts: 1v1 attacking & defending.
- Tactical concepts: Speed of play, switching play, possession in thirds of field and principles of defending.
- Physical: Classroom sessions in nutrition and care & prevention and field sessions in speed, agility and quickness training.
- Mental: Discipline, goal setting and leadership components are incorporated into on and off the field sessions.

Evaluations will be provided for each camper entering their junior years in high school.


#### **Facilities**

The campers at the New York Elite ID Camp will have top-notch facilities available in which to train. Colgate University boasts spacious practice fields that line the back rim of the athletic grounds. Tyler's Field, a lighted turf field, can be utilized during evening sessions and Sanford Field House can be used during poor weather conditions.



## Location

Colgate University is located on Route 12B in Hamilton, New York, 30 miles southwest of Utica and 38 miles southeast of Syracuse. From Syracuse, take the New York State Thruway east to exit 34 (Canastota), Route 5 east to Oneida, and Route 46 south (across Route 20) to 12B South to Hamilton. When driving to campus be sure to pick up Route 12B, not Route 12.
