SERIES SNAPSHOT: This afternoon's game marks the fifth meeting between the Statesmen and the Mariners with Kings Point claiming victory in each of the previous four showdowns. However, the two programs have not squared off since 1970.

NATIONAL RANKINGS: The Statesmen are among the best in the nation in four of the nine team categories tracked by the NCAA. Hobart is 11th in turnover margin (+1.8/g), 26th in rushing defense (87.8 yds/g), 28th in scoring offense (37.0 ppg), and 32nd in total offense (433.4 yds/g).

LIBERTY LEADERS: Hobart ranks first in the Liberty League in scoring offense (37.0 ppg), scoring defense (19.6 ppg), turnover margin (+1.8/g), rushing offense (218.4 yds/g), rushing defense (87.8 yds/g), total offense (433.4 yds/g), pass efficiency (166.5), fourth down conversions (68.8 percent), red zone offense (100 percent), red zone defense (61.1 percent), PAT kicking (100 percent), and kickoff coverage (17.4 yds/ret).

MR. ALL PURPOSE: Senior **DAN SUOZZI** leads the Liberty League in all purpose yards, averaging 145.2 per contest. He's the only player among the top-10 that has yards in all four categories that make up the all purpose category: rushing (3), receiving (438), punt return (155), and kick return (130). Suozzi also handles the punting duties for the Statesmen.

POINTS LEADERS: Speaking of Suozzi, he also leads the Liberty League in scoring, averaging 9.6 points per game. Senior place kicker **ERIC AMPUJA** ranks first among Liberty League kickers with 7.0 ppg. For the season, he is a conference best 23-of-23 on PATs and 3-of-4 on field goals.

SCORING BINGE: With 140 points over the past three weeks, Hobart's offense broke the program's previous high for scoring in a three game span established in 2002 (138, 44 vs. St. Lawrence, 59 at Rochester, and 35 at Franklin & Marshall).

OFFENSIVE FIREWORKS: On Oct. 2, Hobart and WPI combined for 93 points in a 55-38 Statesmen victory, the most points scored by both teams in the 111 seasons of Hobart football. The previous high-water mark was 92 in a 55-37 Hobart romp over the now defunct RIT football team in 1975.

NIFTY FIFTY: By scoring 54 points at RPI and 55 more the following week at home against WPI, this year's Statesmen became the first Hobart squad to score 50-plus points in back-to-back games. In fact, prior to this season, the Statesmen hadn't scored 50-plus points in consecutive seasons since 1955 (53-0 vs. Kenyon) and 1956 (54-0 vs. St. Lawrence).

FIFTY MORE: Since Hobart began sponsoring football in 1891, the program has scored 50-plus points 15 times. Five of those exceptional offensive performances have come under current Head Coach **MIKE CRAGG**, the most of any Statesmen boss.

TECHNICALLY SPEAKING: The Statesmen have feasted on Polytech defenses this season. Hobart outscored Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute 55-13 on Sept. 25, and dispatched Worcester Polytechnic Institute 55-38 on Oct. 2. Which leads one to ask, does Virginia Tech have room for the Statesmen on its schedule?

THIN RED LINE: Hobart has walked away from each of its 20 trips inside the red zone this season with at least three points. The Statesmen have rushed for eight touchdowns, thrown for eight more, and kicked four field goals in the red zone.

THE RED MILE: On the flip side, the Hobart defense has been tough to score against in the red zone. The Statesmen have stopped a League best 61.1 percent of opponents' trips inside the 20-yard line. **MIKE CRAGG's** defense has produced four interceptions, taken over on downs three times, recovered a fumble, watched two field goals miss the mark, and blocked a third three-point attempt.

HOOT-N-HOLLERAN: Senior running back **JACK HOLLERAN** is second in the conference in rushing yards (90.0/gm) and leads the League in average yards per carry (6.1) among backs with at least 10 carries per game.

CATCH OF THE DAY: Senior wide receiver **DAN SUOZZI** clearly has etched his name in the Hobart records book. The native of New Canaan, Conn., already the career receiving yards leader, climbed atop the Statesmen's career receptions and career touchdown receptions lists at home against Coast Guard. Suozzi also tied the one-week old single game record TD catches (4) set by **RICK PIÑERO** against WPI. For his career, Suozzi boasts 148 receptions for 2,287 yards and 20 touchdowns.

BROKEN RECORD: Both **DAN SUOZZI** and **RICK PIÑERO** are on pace to break the single season touchdown receptions record. **SCOTT GEISE's** nine TD catches are the current standard. Suozzi is on pace to pull down 14, while Piñero could log 11.

MODEL OF EFFICIENCY: Sophomore quarterback **SHAWN MIZRO** is among the national leaders in pass efficiency rating. Despite throwing just two passes as a first-year, the native of Newark, N.Y., has excelled in his first season as a starter, completing 70-of-119 for 1,026 yards and 14 touchdowns against just three interceptions for a passer rating of 165.03. He leads the Liberty League and ranks 12th in the nation with only juniors and seniors ranked ahead of him.

LONG RANGE PROJECTIONS: Speaking of **SHAWN MIZRO**, he's on pace to eclipse several of Hobart's single season passing marks. His current numbers for passing touchdowns, passing touchdowns per game, passing yards per attempt, passing yards per completion, and pass efficiency rating all project out to new Hobart records.

LEADING BY EXAMPLE: Senior defensive end **CHRIS PURTELL**, one of four team captains, is leading the team (10th in the conference) in tackles with 37 (16 solo). He also paces the Statesmen with three sacks.

HOW SWEET IT IS: Junior linebacker **ANDREW SWEET** shares the team lead in takeaways. He logged an interception at F&M, and recovered a fumble in each of the past two games. Junior defensive back **JAMIE ANDERSON** also boasts three takeaways, all interceptions.

JUST FOR KICKS: Senior **ERIC AMPUJA** already owns the Hobart career records for PATs made and points by a kicker. He broke the PAT record in 2002 at F&M and currently boasts 104. Ampuja toppled the points by a kicker mark on Oct. 18, 2003, also against the Diplomats, and sports 155 career points. The next mark on his horizon is the career field goals made record established by **SHAWN FAZIO '81** (19). Ampuja has booted four three-pointers this season to raise his total FGM to 17.

MOTIVATIONAL SPEAKER: Only his players know what Coach **MIKE CRAGG** says in the locker room at halftime, but whatever it is, it's working. Since the start of the 2000 season, the third quarter has belonged to Hobart. During that 45 game span, the Statesmen have posted 26 third quarter shutouts and allowed just three teams to score more than seven points: Widener in 2000, Ithaca in 2001, and WPI last week. Having outscored the opposition 288-110 in the third frame, Hobart is 33-12 (.727). Only WPI has scored in the third frame against Hobart this year, against the second string defense.

CAPTAINS: Seniors **ALEX BELL**, **WALT BENNETT**, **TY GODINHO**, and **CHRIS PURTELL** will serve as Hobart's team captains during the 2004 season.

SCOUTING THE MARINERS: Kings Point returns to Brooks Stadium for homecoming looking to post its second win of the season. In their lone victory, the Mariners topped WPI 24-14 in this very stadium. While Kings Point has struggled offensively, averaging a league low 245.8 yds/g of offense, the Mariners do boast the top rusher in the conference, Jason Hardwick (99.5 yds/g). Defensively, linebackers Matt Fuhrman and Josh Hansen lead the team with 52 and 50 tackles, respectively.
