February 23

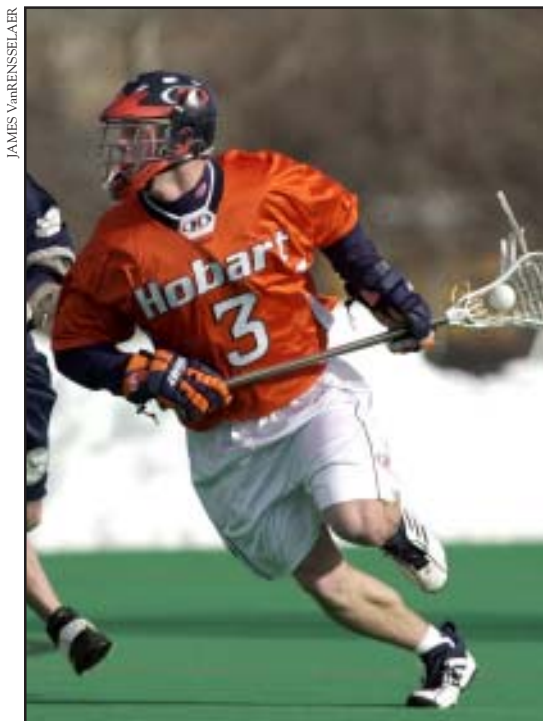

Hobart charged out to an 8-0 halftime lead, with Shore netting the first and last tallies of the half. He finished with two goals and three assists. The other six first half scores came off the sticks of six different Statesmen.
